AMENDED SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION

Successor Declarant and Owners hereby annex to Cliffdweller Ranch, Phase 1 that certain property known are Cliffdweller Ranch, Phase 2, which the following described property would in the County of Washington, water of Utah, including lots and public streets as set forth on the Plat filed of record on the 27th day of September 1996, as Entry No. 545083, legally described as follows: See Exhibit A attached hereto.

- 2. 41 additional Lots are hereby added to the project, which lots are included within the description found at Exhibit A, more particularly set forth in the Planof Childweller Ranch Phase 2, file on the 27th day of September, 1906. Entry No. 345083. The total number of lots the project is now 71 residential tots.
- 3. All lot owners in Cliffdweller Ranch Phase 2 shall become members of the Cliffdweller Ranch Land Owners Association and will be entitled and subject to all rights, powers, provileges, covenants, restrictions, easements, charges, and liens as set forth in the Declaration. The annexed land is to be held, sold, conveyed, encumbered, occupied and improved as part of the subject property under the Declaration.
- The Lot denominated as Huricane Valley Mutual Water Company on the Plat is not a portion of the subdivision, but it is a separate tract of property owned by the water company serving the subdivision and shall not explicit the covenants of the original Declaration of Cliffdweller Ranches and this Supplemental Declaration shall not apply to that piece of property.
- 5. Land Use and Building Type: No property shall be used except for residential purposes. No building shall be erected, altered praced or permitted to remain or any property other than one detacted single-family dwelling parts.

Every dwelling shall, have as a minimum a fully enclosed two car garage. All residences shall have a natural colored driveway, which may be graveled of hard surface, not exceeding sixteen (16) feet in width connecting the parking with a street allowing safe ingress and egress. Construction of residence, shop/barn and any courtyard walls shall be of "Santa Fe/Southwest" design and be of new material. All buildings shall be subject to the approval of the Architectural Control Committee and its rule, and regulations.

An area surrounding the Chadation of the home 30 feet in each direction (courtyard) may be used exclusively by the buyer for patio/landscaping purposes. All septic leech lines shall be contained within this 30 foot envelope

All utility lines from the street to the home shall be underground and located within the driveway right-of-way

An area bordering the rear property line for corals and barns may be cleared and fenced. That area together with the area cleared for the home and courtyard shall not exceed 1/3 of the total lot construction of residence, outbuildings and intercourtyard walls shall be of "Santa Pouthwest" design and be of new materials. All fencing shall be of the windlerials and similar to the existing lengths in the project. The courtyard, outbuildings corrals and driveways he the only areas in which any natural landscape may be disturbed.

 - At least 30 days prior to the issuance of a building permit and concurrent with a request for building architectural approval, a landscape plan of the courtyard area shall be provided to the Committee

- Animals: Horses or similar animals may be bred and or raised on the individual lots. However, the above able number of the foregoing animals shall not exceed three (3) animals becare, excepting birds conforming to County egulations. No other animals, brespect or poultry of any kind shall covaried, bred or kept on any lot, except that dogs, cars or other household pets, not to exceed 3 animals, may be kept provided that they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose and are restricted to the owner's premises or on a leash under the handler's control. Pets shall not be kept if they create that, in the opinion of the Committee, constitutes a nuisance. Notwithstanding the conditions and stipulations of this paragraph, I ots 40 and the shall be restricted from any pages or equestrian use
- Garbage and Refuse Disposal: No lot shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground to bish I rash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept except in sanitary contained. No unsightly materials or other objects are to be stored on any lot in view of the general public or in neighboring lot owners
- Driveways: All driveways, walkways, parking areas and other areas of similar nature shall be of natural coloring and may be graveled or hard surfaced. They must be built in accordance with the approved plans and specification within 60 days of completion of buildings or improvements erected upon the subject lot
