



DESCRIPTION OF HERRIMAN WATER LINE

A pipe line Beginning at the point of division from the natural creek bed, into which water of the U. S. Smelter Refining and Mining Company enters from its Bingham Tunnel, said point being North 1970.0 ft. and West-533.0 ft. from the S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of Sec. 29, T3S, R2W, S. L. B. & M., running thence S. 64°35' E. -198.00 ft., thence within a Salt Lake County road running southeasterly, offset 12.0 ft. northerly from the centerline of road, to a point of intersection of a second County road, the intersection being North-1535.00 ft. and East-718.0 ft. from the aforesaid S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of Sec. 29; thence within the County road property S. 77°58' E.-115.0ft. thence southeasterly to a point North-1213.0 ft. and East-1209.0 ft. from aforesaid  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. Sec. 29, thence S. 33°58' E.-168.0 ft. S. 57°57' E.-1202.0 ft. S.31°00' E-3375.0 ft; thence S. 20°54' E.-714.0 ft. to point above butterfield Canyon Creek Reservoir the point being S. 3124.0 ft. and E. 4315.0 ft. from the S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. of Sec. 29, T3S, R2W, S.L.B. & M.
