AGREEMENT

This Agreement made in quadruplicate this 26th day of July, 1937, between the Property Owners of the land adjacent to and in connection with the creek channel commonly known as Farmington Big Creek, the North Cottonwood Irrigation Company, the Davis County Commissioners and the Utah State Fish and Game Department:

WITNESSES: That the undersigned property owners as aforesaid hereby grant the Utah State Fish and Game Department the right to operate a dragline upon and across the hereinafter described property for the purpose of cleaning the channel of said creek.

These properties contiguous to and transversed by that portion of Farmington Big Creek beginning at a point on the south boundary of the Union Pacific Railroad

Right of way and continuing to the confluence of said creek with Farmington Bay and situated in the Southeast, Northeast and Southwest quarters of Section 24, the North-west quarter of Section 25, the Northeast, Southwest and Southeast quarters of Section 26 and the East half of Section 27, all in Township 3 North, Range 1 West Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

It is further agreed by said property owners that the Utah State Fish and Game Department may make certain changes in the said channel including the right to change its boundaries as necessary or to change the course of said stream as in their judgment may be necessary.

Davis County acting by, and through, its Board of County Commissioners, hereby agree to cooperate to the extent of furnishing the gas and oil for the dragline and caterpillar operation.

It is further agreed between the parties hereto particularly the undersigned property owners and the North Cottonwood Irrigation Company that at the completion of said work said property owners and North Cottonwood Irrigation Company thereafter release the said State Fish and Game Department from any obligation what so ever for the maintenance of said channel, and hereby grant to said State Fish and Game Department such ingress and egress to the above described property as said State Fish and Game Department may deem necessary or advisable in the performance of the duty of said Department.

It is further agreed between the parties hereto that when the irrigation season commences the construction of all necessary turn-outs constructed by the undersigned water users on the above described creek will construct such turnouts in such a manner that no obstruction of water will arise to cause the creek to overflow on any other individual's property, and it is further agreed that when the water turn ends all dams or obstructions constructed in the above described creek will be removed so as not to damage anyone else.

Parties heretofore further agree that the Utah State Fish and Game Department will in no way be responsible for any injury or damage that may arise either to persons or property by reason of the cleaning of said creek channel.
