The East Half (E-1/2) of the North West quarter (NW-1/4) and the West Half (W-1/2) of the North East quarter (ME-1/4), Reserving to the United States all coal in the lands here in conveyed, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove coal from the same, upon compliance with the conditions of and subject to the limitations of an act of Congress approved March 3, 1909, (35 States 844), of Section 22 in Township 2 North Range 5 East of the Salt Lake Meridian, containing One Hundred and Sixty acres, according to the said certificate.

Hobson and to her heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same or any part thereof and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels, telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.
