### Patent

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting; Whereas Rio Grande Western Railway Company of the County of Salt Lake heretofore purchased from the state of Utah the lands herein after described pursuant to the laws of said state in such case made and provided,

And Whereas, the said Rio Grande Western Railway company has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale and the laws of the state duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of One hundred and forty Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the secretary of state of the state of Utah;

Now Therefore, I, Heber M. Wells, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the state of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the state of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said Rio Grande Western Railway Company and to its successors and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land situate in the County of Weber State aforesaid, to wit:
