WHEREAS, it appears to the Board that the public health, convenience and necessity requires the creation of the Wasatch County Special Service District No. 21 for Recreation, commonly known as the "Wasatch County Recreation District" pursuant to Section 17A -2 -1301 et seq. (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and Article XIV, Section 8 of the Utah Constitution; and

WHEREAS, it appears that all of the property to be included in the District will be benefitted by said district and the provision of services as set forth in the creation documents of the District; and

WHEREAS, notice of intent to establish the Wasatch County Special Service District No. 21 for Recreation was published pursuant to the Act and a hearing was held as required by the Act; and

WHEREAS, the time for filing protests provided in the Act has passed and neither the appropriate number of voters nor the appropriate number of property owners have protested the creation of the Wasatch County Special Service District No. 21 for Recreation;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it, and it hereby is, Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Wasatch County, Utah:

Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of the Act and of Article XIV, Section 8 of the Utah Constitution, there is hereby established the Wasatch County Special Service District No. 21 for Recreation, commonly known as the "Wasatch



County Recreation District" which has been more fully described in prior resolutions and notices.


Section 2. That the boundaries of the territory so annexed shall be as shown on the map attached to this resolution as Exhibit A, and more fully described therein.

Section 3. That the services to be provided to the annexed property shall be recreation and related services as set forth in the prior resolutions and notices.

WHEREAS, the proposed district will include all of the area of Midway City; and



WHEREAS, the proposed district will include all of the area of Wallburg City; and




WHEREAS, it appears to the members of the Wallburg City Council that it would be in the best interests of the residents of Wallburg City to be included in the proposed special service district;

WHEREAS, the proposed District shall provide for recreation services and facilities for Heber City residents.

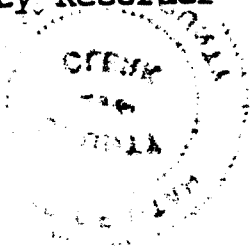

**17-1-29. Wasatch County — Description.**

Wasatch County: Beginning at a point on the summit of the Uintah Range due north of the center line between the east and west range line of range 9 west of the Uintah special meridian, thence southwesterly along the summit of said range to a point east of the headwaters of the Provo River farthest east; thence west to the said headwaters; thence down the middle of the channel of said river to the high bluff below Goddard's Ranch; thence northerly to the point where the road between Rhoads Valley and Salt Lake City crosses the summit of the range south and east of the headwaters of East Canyon and Silver Creeks; thence north to said point of crossing; thence southwesterly along said last mentioned summit to the summit of the Wasatch Range at a point north of a point on the Provo River one-fourth of a mile upstream from the middle of the mouth of the north fork of said river; thence south to the summit of the range east of the headwaters of Hobble and Spanish Fork Creeks; thence southeasterly along said last mentioned summit to the point where the White River and Spanish Fork Road crossed said summit in February, 1880; thence south to the second standard parallel south, Salt Lake base and meridian (which point is also an extension east from the Salt Lake base line of the line between townships 10 and 11 south of Salt Lake meridian); thence east along this line to its intersection with the center line between the east and west range lines of range 9 west of the Uintah special meridian;

thence following the center line of the said range 9 west of the Uintah special meridian to its northern extremity; thence due north to the point of beginning.
