

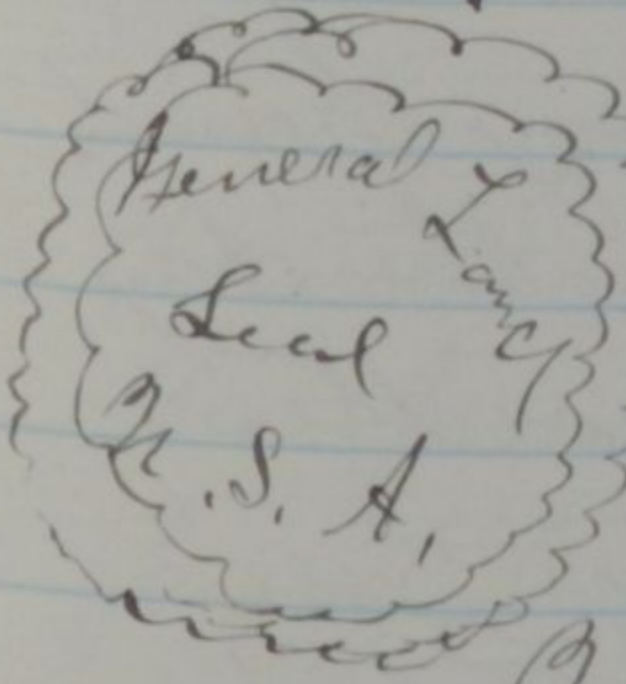

To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting;

Homestead Certificate, No. 1057

Application 1676, — } Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 25th May 1862, "to Secure Homestead to actual - Letters on the Public Domain" And the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Jens Nielson, has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South-half of the North-east quarter of Section nine in Township thirty-six South, of Range eleven west, in the district of lands subject to Sale at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory containing eighty Acres — According to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, Now Know Ye, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Jens Nielson the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Jens Nielson and to his heirs and assigns forever, Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by Law,

Hayes President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed, Given under my hand at the city of Washington the first day of October in the year of our lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine and of the Independence of the United States the One hundred and fourth,
