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This agreement made and entered into this day of 🥽 1974, by and between Clara Stokes, a widow, grantor, which expression shall include his, her, heirs, executors, administrators, agents, or assigns where the context so requires or admits, and the Taylor-West Weber Water Improvement District, grantee, witnesseth:

PARCEL A

WHEREAS, the grantor owns and has title to that real estate and real property located in Weber County, State of Utah, which is referred to below.

AND WHEREAS, grantee desires a perpetual easement and right-of-way for a culinary water pipe line, and a temporary easement and right-of-way for construction use only over property of grantor as is herein more fully set out.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed as follows:

Grantor grants and conveys to grantee a perpetual easement and right-ofway on the following described parcel of property, including the right to enter upon the said real estate at any time it, the said grantee sees fit, and construct, maintain and repair underground pipelines and/or mains for the purpose of conveying culinary water over, across, through and under said land, together with the right to excavate and refill ditches and/or trenches for the location of said pipeline and other obstructions interferring with the location, construction and maintenance of said pipeline and/ or mains; and a temporary easement and right-of-way twenty (20) feet wide, being located on the north side of and adjacent to the perpetual easement for the purpose of initially constructing and laying pipeline and/or main for said culinary water to wit:

A part of the NW 1/4 of Section 2, T5N, R2W, S.L.B. & M. described as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the Southeasterly line of Midland Drive (66 feet wide) and the Southerly line of the said NW 1/4 of

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It is expressly understood and agreed that the Taylor-West Weber Water Improvement District, after the laying of said culinary water pipe line, shall cause the excavation to be backfilled, the pipeline covered and remove from said premises and right-of-way all excess dirt and overburden leaving the said premises in as nearly the original condition as practicable.

And it is further understood and agreed that the said grantee, Taylor-West Weber Water Improvement District, shall have the right of ingress and egress to and from the said perpetual easement and right-of-way at any and all times for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining and repairing said culinary water pipeline and to maintain a storage reservoir on property to the east.
