Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City Utah Territory whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May 1866 "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Charles Parrish has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the South East quarter of Section twenty four in Township five North of Range one East of the Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory containing one hundred and sixty nine acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye, That there is hereby granted by the United States unto the said Charles Parrish the tract of Land above described: To Have and to Hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Charles Parrish and to his heirs and assigns forever: subject to any, vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and the rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs and laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove the ore therefrom. Should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.
