## The United States of America

To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Homestead Certificate No. 4544 }

Application No 7312 } Whereas there has been  
reported in the General Land Office of the United States  
a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt-  
Lake City Utah Territory whereby it appears that  
pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May  
1862 "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on  
the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental  
thereto, the claim of Charles Parrot has been estab-  
lished and duly consummated in conformity to  
law, for the south east quarter of section twenty-  
four in Township five north of Range one East  
of the Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory  
containing one hundred and sixty acres accord-  
ing to the Official Plat of the Survey of the  
said Land, returned to the General Land Office  
by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, That here to therefore granted  
by the United States unto the said Charles Parrot  
the said tract of Land above described: To have and  
to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances  
thereto, unto the said Charles Parrot and to his  
heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested  
and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural,  
manufacturing or other purposes, and the right to  
ditches and reservoirs used in connection with  
such water rights as may be recognized and ac-  
knowledged by the local customs and laws and  
decisions of courts, and also subject to the right  
of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract  
and remove his ore therefrom. Should the same  
be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby  
granted as provided by law.
