Packrell his wife, grantors, of Randolph, County of Rich, State of Utah hereby grants, bargains and sells to the State Road Commission of Utah Grantee, for the sum of Twenty Two and 100/100 Dollars the following described right of way across the grantors land in Rich County State of Utah, as follows: Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 65-D across the grantors land in the 22nd and 23rd sections of T.11.N. R. 7. E. S.14.M. Said right of way is contained within a parcel of land 100 ft. wide 50 ft. on each side of the center line of survey of said project. Said center line is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the south boundary line produced of said grantors land and said center line of survey at engineer's station 882489 which point is 2744.5 ft. North and 2646.5 ft. east from the SW corner of said Section 9, thence N 50° 15' W 515.5 ft. to a point of tangency with a 1° 00' curve to the right, thence northerly 250.0 feet along the arc of said curve, thence N 17° 15' E 500.5 ft. to the intersection with said center line of survey at Engineer's station 856495 and the north boundary line produced of said grantors land, which point is 1090.0 ft. South and 2830.1 ft. east from the NW corner of said Section 9, as shown on the official map of said project on file in the office of the State Road Commission of Utah. Jackson Land & Livestock Company grantor, of Randolph, County of Rich, State of Utah, hereby grants, bargains and sells, to the State Road Commission of Utah Grantee, for the sum of One Hundred Seventy Two and 100/100 dollars the following described right of way across the grantors land in Rich County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 65-D across the grantors land in the 22nd, 23rd, and 24th sections of T.11.N. R. 7. E. S.14.M. Said right of way is contained within a parcel of land 100 ft wide, 50 ft. on each side of the center line of survey of said project. Said center line is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the south line of said Section 9 and said center line of survey at Engineer's station 854401.5 which point is 2300.3 ft. easterly along said south section line from the SW corner of said Section 9, thence N 22° 20' E 345.0 feet, to a point of tangency with a 200 ft 10-Chord spiral for a 4° 00' curve to the left, thence North-easterly 280.0 feet along the arc of said spiral, thence Northerly 542.5 feet along the arc of said 4° 00' curve thence northerly 280.0 feet along the arc of a 200-ft 10-Chord spiral to the left, to Engineer's station 868498.3 back which equals 869402.7 ahead; thence N 15° 15' W 19.2 feet, to the intersection of said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 869422 and the north boundary line produced of said Grantor's land, which point is 1378.0 ft North and 2684.0 ft. Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 65-D across the grantors land in the 22nd and 23rd sections of Section 17 T.11.N. R. 7. E. S.14.M. Said right of way is contained within a parcel of land 100 ft. wide, 50 ft. on each side of the center line of survey of said project, said center line is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the west boundary line of said grantor's land and said center line of survey at Engineer's station 803485 which point is 2328.5 ft South and 1372.1 ft. West from the NE corner of said Section 17 thence North-easterly 99.5 ft. along part of the arc of a 140 ft, 10-chord spiral for a 2° 00' curve to the right to point of tangency to curve (Note: Said spiral at the point of beginning is tangent to a line bearing N.21° 15' E) thence North-easterly 2030.5 ft along said east Section line from said NE corner of Section 17, as shown on the official map of said project on file in the office of the State Road Commission of Utah. Right of way for highway known as F.A. Project No. 65-D across the grantors land in the 22nd and 23rd sections of T.11.N. R. 7. E. S.14.M. Said right of way is a parcel of land 100 ft wide on each side of the center line of survey of said project. Said center line is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the south line of said Section 17 and said center line of survey at Engineer's station 780407 which point is 5405.4 ft. South and 2195.4 ft.
