

This Deed, Made the ... day of ... A.D. 1918, between the Midvale Corporation Of the Church Of Jesus Christ Of Latter-Day Saints, a corporation sole organized and existing under the laws of Utah, party of the first part, and Rev. Yakov Odzich, of Salt Lake City in the County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, to it paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described land and premises, situated in the County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 42.4 rods South and 59.6 rods West from the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Meridian, and running thence West 8.5 rods, thence South 17 rods, thence East 8.5 rods, thence North 17 rods to the place of beginning.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

To Have And To Hold the said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
