THIS DEED Made the day of A.D. 1923 between the Midvale Corporation of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, a corporation sole organized and existing under the laws of Utah, party of the first part, and Midvale City, a municipal corporation, in the County of Salt Lake And State of Utah, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars to it paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all the following described land and premises, situated in the County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, to-wit:

That certain cemetery premises more fully described as commencing at a point 59.40 rods South and 49.60 rods West of the Northeast corner of the South-west quarter of Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Meridian; running thence South 23.00 rods; thence West 20.00 rods; thence North 40.00 rods; thence East 1.50 rods; thence South 17.00 rods; thence East 18.50 rods to the place of beginning.

The above described land being the platted portion of the cemetery grounds directly South of two acre tracts heretofore sold to the Roman Catholic Church and Serbian Orthodox Church respectively, and including a one and one-half (1 1/2) rod roadway running out to 6th Avenue of Midvale City.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever.
