RECEIVED OF AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF WYOMING Ten and no/100 Dollars in consideration of which the undersigned hereby grant and convey unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, its and their respective successors, assigns, lessees, and agents, a right of way and easement to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove such communication systems as the grantee may from time to time require, consisting of under ground cables, wires, conduits, manholes, drains and splicing boxes, surface testing-terminals, repeaters and markers and other appurtenances, upon over and under a strip of land one rod wide, across the land which the undersigned own or in which the undersigned have any interest in the:

South half of Section 33, Township 3 North, Range 5 East, the West half Section 4 and the Northwest quarter of Section 9, Township 2 North, Range 5 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, County of Summit, and State of Utah

together with the following rights: Of ingress and egress over and across the lands of the undersigned to and from said strip for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; to place surface markers beyond said strip; to clear and keep cleared all trees, ^{rocks and} brush, and other obstructions from the surface and subsurface of said strip; to install gates in any fences crossing said strip; and to permit in said strip the cables, wires, circuits and appurtenances of any other company. The northerly or westerly boundary of said one rod strip shall be a line parallel to and three feet northerly or westerly of the first cable laid, which cable shall have its location indicated upon surface markers set at intervals on the lands of the undersigned or on lands adjacent thereto. The undersigned for itself its successors and assigns, hereby covenant that no structure shall be erected or permitted on said strip. The grantees agree to pay for damages to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid systems.
