Silver King Consolidated Mining Co., a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 5 guys and 9 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Summit County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Commencing at a point on Electric Light Lode #730, Park City Mining District which point is located approximately N. 74°50' W. 170 feet from corner # 1 of said lode, thence running S. 59°21' W. 750 feet to west boundary of said lode. (4 poles and 1 guy)
