14. John A. Lambert and Martha A. Lambert his wife, Grantors of Summit County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of one (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distributed and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 2 guy anchors 10 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto for the support of said circuits to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors in Summit County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning at fence on East boundary line of Grantors land at a point 49.0 feet North and 2640 feet East, more or less, from the Southwest corner of Section 18, T. 2 S., R. 6 E. S.L.B&M., thence running S. 45°44' W. 1800 feet, more or less, thence S. 66°24' W. 241, feet to fence on North line of State Highway, (Route No 34) and South boundary line of said land. Also beginning on North boundary line of Grantor's land at a point 930 feet North and 1360 feet East, more or less, from the West quarter of said Section 18, thence running S. 0°43' E. 700 feet, thence S. 0°15' E. 2076 feet, more or less, on said land and being in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 18, in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and Lot 1, Section 19, Township and Range aforesaid. Excepting therefrom that part on County Road.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.

Lewis and Lucille Lewis his wife, Grantors of Summit County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of one (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission and distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 1 guy anchor 1 pole with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors, in Summit County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning at fence on East boundary line of Grantor's land at a point 51.5 feet North and 426 feet west from the Southeast corner of Section 18, T. 2 S. R. 6 E., S.L.B&M. thence running S. 89°44' W. 402 feet to fence on West boundary line of said land and being in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 18, also one guy anchor located on Grantor's land at a point 10 feet North and 1370 feet East, more or less, from the Southwest corner of Section 7, said Township and Range, and being in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 7.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress ^{necessary} convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation, or enjoyment of this easement.
