AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE VACATING an alley running North 127.05 feet from 13th South Street, 132 feet east of 2nd West Street; all abutting property owners having petitioned for the vacation.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. That the alley running north from 13th South Street, and east of 2nd West Street, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot 18, Fox's Subdivision of part of Lot 2, Block 23, 5 Acre Plat A, Big Field Survey; running thence North 122.1 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 19, said subdivision; thence Northeastly 17.2 feet more or less to a point in the west line of Lot 17, said subdivision; thence south 127.05 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 17; thence west 16.5 feet to the point of beginning.

be and the same is hereby vacated and declared no longer to be public property for use as a street, avenue, alley or pedestrian way.

Said vacation is made expressly subject to all existing right-of-way and easements of all public utilities of any and every description now located in, on, under or over the confines of the above described property; and also subject to the rights of entry thereon for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, repairing, replacing, removing, altering or rerouting said utilities and all of them.

SECTION 2. In the opinion of the Board of Commissioners, it is necessary to the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of Salt Lake City that this ordinance become effective immediately; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect upon its first publication.
