ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, JoAnn Matson, being duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 7th day of January, 1991, Case No. 1450-B, by Ian C. England, was heard by the Board. The applicant requested a conditional use on the property at 2157 Lincoln Steet for an accessory building with a basement recreation area in an "R-5" Zone. Variances are requested on height, floor area, and window adjacent to the neighboring property. Legal Description of the property is as follows:

It was moved and seconded that the Board grant the special exception to allow a recreational facility in the basement of the accessory structure in accordance with the plans presented because of, and subject to, the listed provisions.

- 1. The height will be in harmony with the large mansion similar to the former carriage house it replaces;
- 2. A variance is being requested on windows;
- 3. It is located in the rear yard;
- It does not cover more than 50% of the rear yard;
- 5. It may never be used for living quarters or commercial use;
- It is in keeping with the character of the neighborhood.

If a permit is not taken out in 6 months from January \$7, 1991 this variance will become null and void.

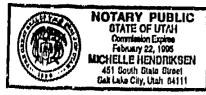
