PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

FERM C. BECKSTEAD and HENRY BECKSTEAD, her husband, and ELVIN COON and ALICE H. GOON, his wife, of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, the owners of the following described real property situated in Salt Lake County, State of Utah, to-wit;

"All of BECKETER'S CHECKTER'S According to the official plat

In consideration of the premises and as part of the general plan for improvement of said property, do hereby declare the property hereinabove described subject to the restrictions and covenants herein recited.

- 1. These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all persons claiming under them from date hereof until June 1st, 1976, at which time said covenants shall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten years unless by vote of a majority of the then owners of the lots it is agreed to change said covenants in whole or in part.
- 2. If the parties hereto, or any of them or their heirs or assigns, shall violate or attempt to violate my of the covenants herein, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any real property situated in the above-described tract to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenants and either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages or other dues for such violation.
- 3. The lidatic, of my one of these covenants by judgment or court order shall be no rise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
- h. All accordsoribal lots in the tract shall be known and described as residential lots. No structures shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain to any residential building plot other than a one-family detached dwolling, not to exceed two stories in height and a private garage for not note than two cars.
- 5. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on any lot mutil the construction plans and specifications and a plan showing the location of the structure have been approved by the architectural control constitute as to could'ty of vorkaneship and materials, harmony of external design with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. No fence or wall shall be erected, placed or altered on any lot nearer to any street than the minimum building setback line unloss similarly approved. The architectural control committee is composed of EMVI COON, FERVIC. RECKETEAD and HEMRY BERETEAD. A majority of the committee may derigante a representative to act for it. In the event of death or resignation of any member of the committee, the remaining members shall have full authority to designate a successor. Neither the members of the committee, nor lite designated representative shall be entitled to any compensation for services performed nursuant to this covenant. At any time, a duly recorded written instrument to change the membership of the committee or to withdraw from the committee or restore to it any of its powers and duties. The committee's approval or disapproval as required in these covenants shall be in writing. In the event the committee, or its designated representative, fails to approve or disapprove within 30 days after plans and specifications have been submitted to it, or in any event, if no suit to onjoin the construction has been commenced prior to the completion thereof, approval will not be required and the related covenants shall be deemed to have been fully complied with.
- 6. No dwelling shall be permitted on any lot at a cost of less than 0.000 ool based upon cost levels provailing on the date these covenants are recorded, it loing the intention and purpose of the covenant to assure

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that all dwellings shall be of a quality of workmanship and materials substantially the same or better than that which can be produced on the date these coverants are recorded at the minimum cost stated herein for the minimum nermitted dwelling size. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open perches and garages, shall be not less than 750 square fect.

- 7. The minimum side yard for any dwelling shall be 8 feet on one side and 12 feet on the other. The minimum setback line for all main buildings shall be 30 feet, and the minimum rear yard for any main building shall be 20 feet. No dwelling shall be erected or placed on any lot having a width of less than 60 feet.
- 8. Easements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved over the rear five feet of each lot.
- 9. No noxious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or may become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- 10. No structure of a temporary character, trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn, or other outpuilding shall be used on any lot at any time as a residence either temporarily or remanently.
