TRUST DEED WITH DUE ON TRANSFER PROVISIONS FIXTURE FILING AND ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS

THIS TRUST DEED WITH DUE ON TRANSFER PROVISIONS, FIXTURE FILING AND ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS, made Murch 27, 2007, between FIB, LC, a Utah limited liability company, as TRUSTOR, whose address is P.O. Box 510507, Salt Lake City, Utah 84151-0507, MOUNTAIN AMERICA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION, 7181 South Campus View Drive, West Jordan, Utah 84084, as TRUSTEE, and MOUNTAIN AMERICA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION, 7181 South Campus View Drive, West Jordan, Utah 84084, as BENEFICIARY,

WITNESSETH: That Trustor CONVEYS AND WARRANTS TO TRUSTEE IN TRUST, WITH POWER OF SALE, the following described property ("Property"), and all of Trustor's right, title and interest therein, situated in Salt Lake County, State of Utah and located at 1605-1615 West 2100 South, Salt Lake City, UT 84119:

See Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and made part hereof by this reference.

Together with all buildings, fixtures and improvements thereon and all water rights, rights of way, easements, rents, issues, profits income, tenements, hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, now or hereafter used or enjoyed with the Property, or any part thereof, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the right, power and authority hereinafter given to and conferred upon Beneficiary to collect and apply such rents, issues, and profits.

Trustor also hereby grants to Beneficiary a security interest in the following items associated with the Property:

- (1) All buildings, improvements, works, structures, facilities and fixtures, including trade fixtures, now owned or hereafter acquired, or hereafter constructed upon or at any time located upon the Property, including, but not limited to, all plumbing, heating and electrical systems, water heaters, air conditioning units, sewage systems, all pipes, conduits, wiring, and all interior wall, floor, window and ceiling treatments and coverings including but not limited to, any carpeting, tile, paneling, drapery or blinds and any future additions to and improvements and betterments now or hereafter constructed upon, the Property, together with all replacements, attachments, parts, accessories, accessions and tools belonging thereto or for use in connection with any of the foregoing, which are now or hereafter shall be constructed or affixed or constructively affixed to the Property, or to any portion of the Property, and proceeds thereof;
- (2) All awards made for the taking by eminent domain or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu thereof of the Property or any portion of the Property, or of any improvements now or hereafter situate hereon or any estate or easement in the Property, including any awards for change of grade of streets, and the proceeds of insurance paid on account of partial or total destruction of the Property, or improvements thereon, or any portion thereof; and
 - (3) All rents, subrents, issues, royalties, income and profits of and from the Property, or any portion thereof.

The above conveyance and grant is made FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING (1) payment of the indebtedness evidenced by a promissory note of even date herewith, in the principal sum of ONE MILLION EIGHTY-SEVEN

THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED and no/100 dollars, made by FIB, LC, payable to the order of Beneficiary at the times, in the manner and with interest as therein set forth, and any extensions and/or renewals or modifications thereof; (2) the performance of each agreement of Trustor herein contained; (3) the payment of such additional loans or advances as hereafter may be made to Trustor, or his successors or assigns, when evidenced by a promissory note or notes reciting that they are secured by this Trust Deed; and (4) the payment of all sums expended or advanced by Beneficiary under or pursuant to the terms hereof, together with interest thereon as herein provided.

TO PROTECT THE SECURITY OF THIS TRUST DEED, TRUSTOR AGREES:

- 1. To keep the Property in good condition and repair; not to remove or demolish any building thereon, to complete or restore promptly and in good and workmanlike manner any building which may be constructed damaged or destroyed thereon; to comply with all laws, covenants and restrictions affecting the Property; not to commit or permit waste thereof; not to commit, suffer or permit any action upon the Property in violation of law; to do all other acts which from the character or use of the Property may be reasonably necessary, the specific enumerations herein not excluding the general; and, if the loan secured hereby or any part hereof is being obtained for the purpose of financing construction of improvements on the Property, Trustor further agrees:
 - (a) To commence construction promptly and to pursue same with reasonable diligence to completion in accordance with plans and specifications satisfactory to Beneficiary, and
 - (b) To allow Beneficiary to inspect the Property at all times during construction

Trustee, upon presentation to it of an affidavit signed by Beneficiary, setting forth facts showing a default by Trustor under this numbered paragraph, is authorized to accept as true and conclusive all facts and statements therein, and to act thereon hereunder.

- 2. To provide and maintain insurance, of such type or types and amounts as Beneficiary may require, on the improvements now existing or hereafter erected or placed on the Property. Such insurance shall be carried in companies approved by Beneficiary with loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to Beneficiary. In event of loss, Trustor shall give immediate notice to Beneficiary, who may make proof of loss, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to Beneficiary instead of to Trustor and Beneficiary jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by Beneficiary, at its option, to reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged.
- 3. To deliver to, pay for and maintain with Beneficiary until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, such evidence of title as Beneficiary may require, including abstracts of title or policies of title insurance and any extensions or renewals thereof or supplements thereto.
- 4. To appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security hereof, the title to the Property, or the rights or powers of Beneficiary or Trustee; and should Beneficiary or Trustee elect to also appear in or defend any such action or proceeding, to pay all costs and expenses, including cost of evidence of title and attorney's fees in a reasonable sum incurred by Beneficiary or Trustee.
- 5. To pay at least 10 days before delinquency all taxes and assessments affecting the Property, including all assessments upon water company stock and all rents, assessments and charges for water, appurtenant to or used in connection with the Property; to pay, when due, all encumbrances, charges, and liens with interest on the Property or any part thereof, which at any time appear to be prior or superior hereto; to pay all costs, fees, and expenses of this Trust.
- 6. Should Trustor fail to make any payment or to do any act as herein provided, then Beneficiary or Trustee, but without obligation so to do and without notice to or demand upon Trustor and without releasing Trustor from any obligation hereof, may: Make or do the same in such manner and to such extent as either may deem necessary to protect the security hereof, Beneficiary or Trustee being authorized to enter upon the Property for such purposes; commence, appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security hereof or the rights or powers of Beneficiary or Trustee; pay, purchase, contest, or compromise any encumbrance, charge or lien which in the judgment of either appears to be prior or superior hereto; and in exercising any such powers, incur any liability, expend whatever amounts in its absolute discretion it may deem necessary therefor, including cost of evidence of title, employ counsel, and pay his reasonable fees.

7. To pay immediately and without demand all sums expended hereunder by Beneficiary or Trustee, with interest from date of expenditure at the rate of eighteen percent (18%) per annum until paid, and the repayment thereof shall be secured hereby.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

- 8. Should the Property or any part thereof be taken or damaged by reason of any public improvement or condemnation proceeding, or damaged by fire, or earthquake, or in any other manner, Beneficiary shall be entitled to all compensation, awards, and other payments or relief therefor, and shall be entitled at its option to commence, appear in and prosecute in its own name, any action or proceedings, or to make any compromise or settlement, in connection with such taking or damage. All such compensation, awards, damages, rights of action and proceeds, including the proceeds of any policies of fire and other insurance affecting the Property, are hereby assigned to Beneficiary, who may, after deducting therefrom all its expenses, including attorney's fees, apply the same on any indebtedness secured hereby. Trustor agrees to execute such further assignments of any compensation, award, damages, and rights of action and proceeds as Beneficiary or Trustee may require.
- 9. At any time and from time to time upon written request of Beneficiary, payment of its fees and presentation of this Trust Deed and the note for endorsement (in case of full reconveyance, for cancellation and retention), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, Trustee may (a) consent to the making of any map or plat of the Property; (b) join in granting any easement or creating any restriction thereon; (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Trust Deed or the lien or charge thereof; (d) reconvey, without warranty, all or any part of the Property. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as "the person or persons entitled thereto", and the recitals therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of truthfulness thereof. Trustor agrees to pay reasonable Trustee's fees for any of the services mentioned in this paragraph.
- 10. As additional security, Trustor hereby assigns Beneficiary, during the continuance of these trusts, all rents, issues, royalties, and profits of the property affected by this Trust Deed and of any personal property located thereon. Until Trustor shall default in the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in the performance of any agreement hereunder, Trustor shall have the right to collect all such rents, issues, royalties, and profits earned prior to default as they become due and payable. If Trustor shall default as aforesaid, Trustor's right to collect any of such moneys shall cease and Beneficiary shall have the right, with or without taking possession of the property affected hereby, to collect all rents, royalties, issues, and profits. Failure or discontinuance of Beneficiary at any time or from time to time to collect any such moneys shall not in any manner affect the subsequent enforcement by Beneficiary of the right, power, and authority to collect the same. Nothing contained herein, nor the exercise of the right by Beneficiary to collect, shall be, or be construed to be, an affirmation by Beneficiary of any tenancy, lease or option, nor an assumption of liability under, nor a subordination of the lien or charge of this Trust Deed to any such tenancy, lease or option.
- 11. Upon any default by Trustor hereunder, Beneficiary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent, or by a receiver to be appointed by a court (Trustor hereby consenting to the appointment of Beneficiary as such receiver), and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of the Property or any part thereof, in its own name sue for or otherwise collect said rents, issues, and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the same, less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including reasonable attorney's fees, upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as Beneficiary may determine.
- 12. The entering upon and taking possession of the Property, the collection of such rents, issues, and profits, or the proceeds of fire and other insurance policies, or compensation or awards for any taking or damage of the Property, and the application or release thereof as aforesaid, shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.
- 13. The failure on the part of Beneficiary to promptly enforce any right hereunder shall not operate as a waiver of such right and the waiver by Beneficiary of any default shall not constitute a waiver of any other or subsequent default.
- 14. Time is of the essence hereof. Upon default by Trustor in the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in the performance of any agreement hereunder, all sums secured hereby shall immediately become due and payable at the option of Beneficiary. In the event of such default, Beneficiary may execute or cause Trustee to execute a written notice of default and of election to cause the Property to be sold to satisfy the obligations hereof, and Trustee shall file

such notice for record in each county wherein the Property or some part or parcel thereof is situated. Beneficiary also shall deposit with Trustee, the note and all documents evidencing expenditures secured hereby.

- 15. After the lapse of such time as may then be required by law following the recordation of said notice of default, and notice of default and notice of sale having been given as then required by law, Trustee, without demand on Trustor, shall sell the Property on the date and at the time and place designated in said notice of sale, either as a whole or in separate parcels, and in such order as it may determine (but subject to any statutory right of Trustor to direct the order in which such property, if consisting of several known lots or parcels, shall be sold), at public auction to the highest bidder, the purchase price payable in lawful money of the United States at the time of sale. The person conducting the sale may, for any cause he deems expedient, postpone the sale in accordance with the law then in effect from time to time until it shall be completed and, in every case, notice of postponement shall be given by public declaration thereof by such person at the time and place last appointed for the sale; provided, if the sale is postponed for longer than the time allowed by law beyond the day designated in the notice of sale, notice thereof shall be given in the same manner as the original notice of sale. Trustee shall execute and deliver to the purchaser its Deed conveying the Property so sold, but without any covenant or warranty, express or implied. The recitals in the Deed of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Any person, including Beneficiary, may bid at the sale. Trustee shall apply the proceeds of the sale to payment of (1) the costs and expenses of exercising the power of sale and of the sale, including the payment of the Trustee's and attorney's fees; (2) cost of any evidence of title procured in connection with such sale and revenue stamps on Trustee's Deed; (3) all sums expended under the terms hereof, not then repaid, with accrued interest at 10% per annum from date of expenditure; (4) all other sums then secured hereby; and (5) the remainder, if any, to the person or persons legally entitled thereto, or the Trustee, in its discretion, may deposit the balance of such proceeds with the County Clerk of the county in which the sale took place.
- 16. Upon the occurrence of any default hereunder, Beneficiary shall have the option to declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable and foreclose this Trust Deed in the manner provided by law for the foreclosure of mortgages on real property and Beneficiary shall be entitled to recover in such proceeding all costs and expenses incident thereto, including a reasonable attorney's fee in such amount as shall be fixed by the court.
- 17. Beneficiary may appoint a successor trustee at any time by filing for record in the office of the County Recorder of each county in which the Property or some part thereof is situated, a substitution of trustee. From the time the substitution is filed for record, the new trustee shall succeed to all the powers, duties, authority and title of the trustee named herein or of any successor trustee. Each such substitution shall be executed and acknowledged, and notice thereof shall be given and proof thereof made, in the manner provided by law.
- 18. This Trust Deed shall apply to, inure to the benefit of, and bind all parties hereto, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns. All obligations of Trustor hereunder are joint and several. The term "Beneficiary" shall mean the owner and holder, including any pledgee, of the note secured hereby. In this Trust Deed, whenever the context requires, the masculine gender includes the feminine and/or neuter, and the singular number includes the plural.
- 19. Trustee accepts this Trust when this Trust Deed, duly executed and acknowledged, is made a public record as provided by law. Trustee is not obligated to notify any party hereto of pending sale under any other Trust Deed or of any action or proceeding in which Trustor, Beneficiary, or Trustee shall be a party, unless brought by Trustee.
- 20. Trustor, and any guarantor of the note secured by this trust deed, shall not be entitled to claim or assert any local defense or immunity, including those found in Utah Code Annotated 57-1-32, to a deficiency action on the note secured hereby or an action on any guaranty thereof, even if this trust deed is foreclosed pursuant to Utah's trust deed statute. In the event the property covered by this trust deed is sold at a judicial foreclosure sale or pursuant to the power of sale hereinabove granted, and the proceeds are not sufficient to pay the total indebtedness secured by this instrument, the beneficiary will be entitled to a deficiency judgement for the amount of the deficiency without regard to appraisement or time elapsement.
- 21. The undersigned Trustor requests that a copy of any notice of default and of any notice of sale hereunder be mailed to him at the address hereinbefore set forth.
 - 22. TRANSFER OF THE REAL PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER. If all or any part

of the Real Property, or any interest therein, is sold or transferred by Borrower, or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person or persons but is limited partnership, limited liability company, limited liability partnership, general partnership, trust or other legal entity, without Lender's prior written consent (including a transfer by devise, descent, or by operation of law upon death or otherwise), which consent may be withheld by Lender in Lender's sole discretion, then Lender may, at Lender's option, declare all the sums secured by the Deed of Trust to be immediately due and payable.

If Lender exercises such option to accelerate, Lender shall mail Borrower notice of acceleration. Such notice shall provide a period of not less than thirty (30) days from the date the notice is mailed within which Borrower may pay the sums declared due. If Borrower fails to pay such sums prior to the expiration of such period, Lender may, without further notice or demand on Borrower, invoke any remedies permitted by the Deed of Trust for collection, possession, and foreclosure.

Lender may consent to, but shall not be required to consent to, a sale or transfer if: (a) Borrower causes to be submitted to Lender information required by Lender to evaluate the transferee as if a new loan were being made to the transferee; (b) Lender, in Lender's sole discretion, determines that Lender's security will not be impaired and that the risk of a breach, default, or Event of Default with respect to any covenant or agreement in the Deed of Trust is acceptable; (c) interest will be payable on the sums secured by the Deed of Trust at a rate acceptable to Lender; and (d) changes in the terms of that certain Non-Revolving Promissory Note (the "Note") executed in connection herewith and the Deed of Trust required by Lender, in Lender's sole discretion, are made including, but not limited to, periodic adjustments in the interest rate, a different final payment date for the Loan, and the addition of unpaid interest of principal. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Lender also may charge a reasonable fee as a condition to Lender's consent to any sale or transfer.

- 23. Borrower will continue to be primarily obligated under the Note, the Deed of Trust, and the other Loan Documents unless Lender releases Borrower in writing.
- 24. The undersigned Trustor requests that a copy of any notice of default and of any notice of sale hereunder be mailed to him at the address hereinbefore set forth.
