Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said

E. J. REBER

forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of ITUA State of UTAH

to-wit: The West-half (1/2) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4), the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the North-east Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Eight (8), Township Forty-one (41) North, Range Sixteen (16) West of the Salt Lake Meridian

reserving to the State of Utah, all coal and other minerals in the above land, and so that no persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove coal and other minerals, shall be granted or conveyed in the counties and subject to the limitations of Title 86-Chapter 1, Revised Statutes of Utah 1903 and amendments thereto.)
