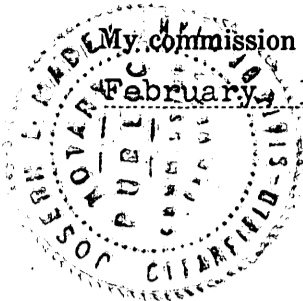

Lott, ~~wife~~ Grantor, of Utah County, Utah, does hereby convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, relocation and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, telephone and telegraph circuits of the Grantee, and ~~no~~ two pole towers and ~~no~~ guy anchors with the necessary guys, stubs, cross arms, braces and other attachments affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, on, under, over, through, and across a tract of land fifty (50) feet in width, located in Utah County, Utah, and being twenty-five (25) feet on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at fence on west boundary line of Grantor's land at a point 280 feet north and 660 feet west, more or less, from the southeast corner of Section 18, T. 5 S., R. 1 E., S.L.B. & M., thence running S. 65°19' E. 365 feet, more or less, to south boundary line of said land and being in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 18.

This easement granted, subject to the condition that the grantee pay all reasonable damages, during the construction, maintenance or inspection of said line over the premises.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.

County, Utah, does hereby convey... and warrant... to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY... a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, relocation and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, telephone and telegraph circuits of the Grantee, and one two pole towers and no guy anchors with the necessary guys, stubs, cross arms, braces and other attachments affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, on, under, over, through, and across a tract of land fifty (50) feet in width, located in Utah County, Utah, and being twenty-five (25) feet on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning on north boundary line of Grantor's land at a point 125 feet north and 320 feet west, more or less, from the southeast corner of Section 18, T. 5 S., R. 1 E., S.L.B.& M., thence running S. 65°19' E. 500 feet, more or less, to fence on south boundary line of said land and being in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 18, the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 19 and the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 20, Township and Range aforesaid.
