The Resolution was then signed by the Chair in open meeting and recorded by the Clerk/Auditor in the official records of Utah County, Utah. The Resolution is as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (THE "BOARD") OF UTAH COUNTY, UTAH, TO CREATE THE POLE CANYON BASIC LOCAL DISTRICT DESCRIBED IN THE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED CREATION OF BASIC LOCAL DISTRICT ADOPTED BY THE BOARD ON JANUARY 13, 2009, AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Utah County, Utah (the "County"), adopted a resolution (the "Resolution") proposing the creation of a basic local district to be known as the "Pole Canyon Basic Local District" (the "Pole Canyon District") pursuant to the provisions of the Limited Purpose Local Government Entities—Local Districts, Title 17B, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended (the "Act"), for the purposes of providing for (a) the acquisition, construction, and operation of parks or recreation facilities or services, (b) transportation including public transit and streets and roads, (c) the acquisition, construction, and operation of a system, or one or more components of a system, for the collection, storage, retention, control, conservation, treatment, supplying, distribution, or reclamation of water, including storm, flood, sewage, irrigation, and culinary water, and (d) the underground installation of electric utility wires within the Pole Canyon District;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Resolution, a "Notice of Public Hearing on the Proposed Creation of Basic Local District" (the "Notice") has been provided as required by law and is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit B</u>;

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2009, the Board held a public hearing at which it considered each and every protest filed and every person who wished to be heard in protest against the creation of the Pole Canyon District or on any other matter pertinent to the Pole Canyon District;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that there are no registered voters within the boundaries of the Pole Canyon District and therefore no election is required on the question of whether the Pole Canyon District should be created; and

WHEREAS, the Pole Canyon District's boundaries are located entirely within the County which, for purposes of the Act, is considered the "responsible body":

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UTAH COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All terms defined in the recitals hereto shall have the same meaning when used herein. All action heretofore taken (not inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution) by the Board and by the officers of the County directed toward the creation and establishment of the Pole Canyon District, are hereby ratified, approved, and confirmed.

- Section 2. The Pole Canyon District, to be formally known as the "Pole Canyon Basic Local District," is hereby created and authorized to finance the improvements described in the Notice.
- Section 3. Upon further consideration, the Board has determined that certain parcels of land should be removed from the boundaries of the Pole Canyon District as described in the Resolution. The revised area to be included within the Pole Canyon District is described in Exhibit C attached hereto and is hereby approved by the Board. A map showing the final boundaries of the Pole Canyon District is attached hereto as Exhibit D.
- Section 4. The initial Board of Trustees of the Pole Canyon District will be appointed by the Board of the County, as the "responsible body" under the Act. The officers of the County are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and post a Notice of Vacancy in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit E and take such other actions necessary or appropriate under the Act to appoint the initial Board of Trustees of the Pole Canyon District.
- Section 5. The County Clerk/Auditor is hereby authorized to file or cause to be filed with the Utah Lieutenant Governor (i) a copy of a notice of an impending boundary action, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit F and (ii) a copy of an approved final local entity plat, to obtain a certificate of incorporation for the Pole Canyon District within ten (10) days of the adoption of this resolution.
- <u>Section 6.</u> The officers of the County are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution.
- Section 7. If any one or more sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be questioned or held invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Resolution, but shall be confined in its operation to the specific sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution so held unconstitutional and invalid, and the inapplicability and invalidity of any section, sentence, clause, or part of this Resolution in any one or more instances shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of this Resolution in any other instances.
- Section 8. All resolutions of the County in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any Resolution, by-law or regulation, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT pursuant to the provisions of the Limited Purpose Local Government Entities-Local Districts, Title 17B, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended (the "Act"), on January 13, 2009 the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Utah County, Utah (the "County"), adopted a Resolution to initiate the creation of a basic local district to be known as the "Pole Canyon Basic Local District" (the "District") for the purposes of providing for (a) the acquisition, construction and operation of parks or recreation facilities or services, (b) transportation, including public transit and streets and roads, (c) the acquisition, construction and operation of a system, or one or more components of a system, for the collection, storage, retention, control, conservation, treatment, supplying, distribution, or reclamation of water, including storm, flood, sewage, irrigation, and culinary water, and (d) the underground installation of electric utility lines within the proposed District. The Resolution provides for a public hearing on the creation of the proposed District to be held at Eagle Mountain City Building, 1650 East Stagecoach Run, Eagle Mountain, Utah County, Utah, at 6:00 p.m. on February 9, 2009, at which time all interested parties may appear and ask questions of and obtain further information regarding the creation of the proposed District.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED AREA TO BE INCLUDED IN THE DISTRICT

The District shall have the boundaries reflected in the map attached to this notice as <u>Exhibit A</u>. For a legal description of the proposed District, see the Resolution adopted by the Board on January 13, 2009.

PROPOSED SERVICES

The District will be authorized to provide for (a) the acquisition, construction and operation of parks or recreation facilities or services, (b) transportation, including public transit and streets and roads, (c) the acquisition, construction and operation of a system, or one or more components of a system, for the collection, storage, retention, control, conservation, treatment, supplying, distribution, or reclamation of water, including storm, flood, sewage, irrigation, and culinary water, and (d) the underground installation of electric utility lines within the District, together with necessary facilities, appurtenances, and equipment therefore.

ANTICIPATED METHOD OF FINANCING

It is anticipated that the District will finance the proposed services using one or more of the following methods: (a) the District may designate an assessment area to finance capital improvements and may issue assessment bonds secured by assessments levied against benefited property; (b) the District may impose fees and charges to pay for certain services and may issue revenue bonds secured by said fees and charges; and (c) the District may annually levy taxes upon all taxable property within the District to provide the proposed services, and may issue bonds for the acquisition and/or construction of facilities to provide said services, provided, however, that said levy to provide said services or to repay said bonds, must be authorized and approved by a majority of the qualified electors of the District at an election for that purpose.

ESTIMATED AVERAGE FINANCIAL IMPACT ON HOUSEHOLD WITHIN PROPOSED DISTRICT

There are currently no residents within the boundaries of the proposed District with which to compute an average financial impact on a household. Based on estimates for the number of households that are currently anticipated to be located within the District once it is fully developed, the creation of the District will result in an estimated average financial impact of \$35,000 on a household within the proposed District.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PROPOSED DISTRICT

The governing body of the District will consist of a Board of Trustees comprised of three members, all of whom shall be appointed to such office by the Board of the County Since the proposed District currently has fewer than one residential dwelling unit per ten acres of land within the District, a member of the Board of Trustees must be (a) a registered voter and (b) an owner of land within the proposed District that will receive service from the proposed District, or an agent or officer of an owner.

The term of the members of the Board of Trustees shall begin upon the appointment of said members. The term for the members shall be four years, provided that the initial term of one member shall be two years so that the term of approximately half of the members of the Board of Trustees shall expire every two years, and provided further that the initial terms of the members shall be adjusted to expire on the first Monday of January, 2012 and 2014, respectively, such that the next term of all members shall begin the first Monday of January in the appropriate year.

Upon the issuance of a certificate of occupancy for the last lot subject to occupancy within the District (whether commercial or residential), the method for selecting members of the Board of Trustees shall transition to an election procedure, commencing with the first municipal general election at which the applicable election requirements can be met.

PUBLIC HEARING ON CREATION OF PROPOSED DISTRICT

The Board will hold a public hearing on the creation of the proposed District and its provision of the proposed services described above at 6:00 p.m. on February 9, 2009, at the following location: Eagle Mountain City Building, 1650 East Stagecoach Run, Eagle Mountain, Utah County, Utah. Any interested person may protest the creation of the proposed District or the furnishing of services therein either orally at the hearing or in writing, at or at any time prior to the hearing, or within 60 days of the conclusion of the hearing. Written protests must be filed with the County Clerk.

Any protest signed on behalf of a corporation owning property in the District shall be sufficient if it is signed by the president, vice president, or any duly authorized agent of the corporation. Where title to any property is held in the name of more than one person, all of the persons holding title to the property must join in the signing of the protest.

At said public hearing, the Board will give full consideration to all protests which shall have been filed and will hear and consider all interested persons desiring to be heard. The Board may continue the hearing to another date and time if necessary. After conclusion of the hearing and after the time for filing protests has expired, unless said time for filing protests has been waived by all property owners within the proposed District, in which case the Board may adopt immediately after the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board shall adopt a resolution either creating the District or determining that the creation of the District should be abandoned.

Unless the time for filing protests has been waived by all property owners within the proposed District, if, within sixty (60) days after the conclusion of the hearing, protests are filed with the County Clerk/Auditor that are signed by (i) the owners of private real property located within the District which covers at least 25% of the total private land area within the District and is equal in value to at least 15% of the value of all private real property within the District or (ii) registered voters residing within the District equal in number to at least 25% of the number of votes cast in the District for the office of governor at the last general election, then the Board may not take any further action under the protested resolution to create the District.

MAP OF POLE CANYON BASIC LOCAL DISTRICT AREA


