THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this

day of 1947,

by the between the OREGON SHORT LIDE RAILECAD COMPANY, a
corporation of the State of Utah, and its Lessee, UNION
PACIFIC RAILECAD COMPANY, a corporation of the State of
Utah, (hereinafter collectively called "Railroad Company"),
parties of the first part, and MOUNTAIN FUEL SUPPLY COMPANY,
a corporation of the State of Utah, (hereinafter called
"Licensee"), party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

RECITALS:

The Licensee desires to construct and thereafter, during the term hereof, maintain and operate a three quarter (5/4) inch high pressure gas pipe line (hereinafter called "pipe line") across the right of way and undermeath spur track No. 170 of the Railroad Company at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Utah.

To set out the terms and conditions under which said pipe line shall be constructed, maintained and operated across the right of way and underneath the roadbed and track of the Railread Company, this agreement is made.

AGREEMENT:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows, to-wit:

For and in consideration of the covenants and payments hereinafter mentioned to be performed and made by the Licensee, and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter stated, the Railread Company hereby grants unto the Licensee the right to construct and thereafter, during the term hereof, to maintain and operate said pipe line under Spur Track
No. 178 of the Railread Company at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake
Compty, With, substantially in the location shown in yellow
on the attached print, dated March 28, 1947, marked Exhibit
and bereit made a part hereof.

The foregoing grant is subject and subordinate to the prior and centinuing right and obligation of the Rail-road Semeny to use and maintain its entire railroad right is the perfermance of its public duty as a common and is also subject to the right and power of the construct, maintain, repair, renew, construct, maintain, repair, renew, construct, maintain, repair, renew, construct, signal or ether pole and wire lines,

pipe lines and other facilities upon, along or across any or all parts of said right of way, all or any of which may be freely done at any time or times by the Railroad Company without liability to the Licensee or to any other party for compensation or damages.

The foregoing grant is also subject to all outstanding superior rights (including those in favor of telegraph and telephone companies, lessees of said right of way, and others), and the right of renewals and extensions of the same.

2. CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION:

The pipe line shall be constructed of continuous steel pipe, having an internal diameter of three quarters of an inch, and said pipe line shall be constructed, maintained, operated, repaired and renewed by the Licensee in strict conformity with Specification C.S. 1029 of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, which is hereby, by reference, made a part hereof.

The Licensee shall keep and maintain the soil over said pipe line thoroughly compacted and the grade even with the adjacent surface of the ground.

All work performed on said right of way and under the roadbed and tracks of the Railroad Company in connection with the construction, maintenance, repair, renewal or reconstruction of the pipe line shall be done under the supervision of, and in a manner satisfactory to, the Railroad Company.

Prior to the commencement of any work in connection with the construction, maintenance, repair, renewal or reconstruction of said pipe line where it extends underneath the roadbed and tracks of the Railroad Company, the Licensee shall submit to the Railroad Company plans setting out the method and manner of handling the work and shall not proceed with the work until such plans shall have been approved by the District Engineer of the Railroad Company and then only under the supervision of said District Engineer or his representative. The Railroad Company shall have the right, if it so elects, to provide such support as it may deem necessary for the safety of its tracks during the time of construction, main tenance, repair, renewal or reconstruction of the pipe line.

5. NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT OF WORK:

The Licensee shall notify the Railroad Company at least forty-eight hours in advance of the commencement of any work upon said right of way or under the roadbed and

such advance notice shall not be required in cases of emergency where it is necessary for the Licensee to enter upon said right of way for the purpose of stopping or repairing leaks.

4. LIGHTSEE TO BEAR ENTIRE EXPENSE:

The Licensee shall bear the entire cost and expense incurred in scannection with the construction, maintenance, repair, remewal and any and all modification, revision, relocation, removal or reconstruction of the pipe Lime, including any and all expense which may be incurred by the Railread Company in connection therewith for supervision, inspection or otherwise.

The Licensee shall, at its sole expense, make any and all modifications or changes in the pipe line, or move all er any part of said pipe line to such new location as may be required by the Railroad Company at any time in conmection with the construction, maintenance, repair, renewal, use, operation, change, modification or relocation of railroad tracks, telegraph, telephone, signal or other pole and wire lines, pipe lines and other facilities of the Railroad Company.

All the terms, conditions and stipulations herein expressed with reference to the construction, maintenance, repair and renewal of said pipe line in the location herein-before described shall apply to the pipe line as modified, changed or relocated within the contemplation of this section.

The Licensee shall promptly pay or discharge all taxes, rates, charges and assessments levied upon, in respect to, or on account of the pipe line, so as to prevent the same becoming a charge or lien upon said right of way, or any other property of the Railroad Company, and so that the taxes, charges and assessments levied upon or in respect to said right of way and other property of the Railroad Company shall not be increased because of the location, construction or maintenance of the pipe line or any improvement, appliance or fixture connected therewith placed upon said right of way, or on account of the Licensee's interest theresin. Where such tax, charge or assessment may not be separately made or assessed to the Licensee, but shall be included in the assessment of the right of way or other property of the Railroad Company, then the Licensee shall pay to the Railroad Company, an equitable proportion of such taxes determined by the value of the Licensee's property upon said right of way, as compared with the entire value of said right of way.

8. RESTORATION OF RAILROAD COMPANY'S PROPERTY:

In the event the Licensee shall in any manner move or disturb any property of the Railroad Company in connection with the construction, maintenance, repair, renewal or reconstruction of the pipe-line, then and in that event the Licensee shall, as soon as possible and at its sole expense, restore such property to the same condition as it was in before such property was moved or disturbed, and the Licensee shall indemnify and save harmless the Railroad Company from and against any and all liability, loss, damages, claims, demands, costs and expenses of whatsoever nature, including court costs and attorneys' fees, which may result from injury to or death of persons whomsoever or damage to or loss or destruction of property whatsoever, when such injury, death, damage, loss or destruction grows out of or arises from the moving or disturbance of any property of the Railroad Company.

9. DISPOSAL OF RIGHT OF WAY:

In the event the Railroad Company shall dispose of any of its right of way upon which the pipe line is located, as herein provided, the license or permit herein granted, with respect to the portion or portions of the pipe line as may be located upon the right of way so disposed of, shall forthwith cease and determine.

10. LIABILITY:
The Licensee shall indemnify and hold harmless the
Railroad Company from and against any and all liability,

th. TREMENATION, ABANDONMENT OR DEFAULT:
Disuse of said pipe line continuing at any time for a period of one year shall constitute an abandonment thereof, and in the event of such an abandonment the Railroad Company may, at its eption, terminate this agreement with respect to the pipe line so abandoned.

If the Licensee shall fail to keep and perform all er any of the evenants and agreements herein contained to be by the Licensee kept and performed, or if the Licensee shall fail to make any of the payments which it is obligated to make hereunder, and such default shall continue for a period of thirty (50) days after written notice from the failread Sempany to the Licensee specifying such default, then the failread Gempany may, at its option, forthwith terminate this agreement.

18. REMOVAL OF PIPE LINE OF LICENSEE:

Mithin minety (90) days after the termination of this agreement with respect to any portion of the pipe line, the Linear shall, at its sele expense, remove from those pertiens of said right of way not occupied by the roadbed and tracks of the Railroad Company such pertien of the pipe line and shall restore, to the satisfaction of the Railroad Company, said pertiens of said right of way to as good condition of the pertiens of said right of way to as good condition of the line; and if the Licensee fails so to do, the Railroad Company may be such work of removal and restoration at the same of the Licensee. In the event of the removal of the pipe line or any portion thereof, as in this section provided, the Rail-road Company shall in no manner be liable to the Licensee for any damage sustained by the Licensee for or on account of such removal, and such removal shall in no manner prejudice or impair any right of action for damages, or otherwise, that the Railroad Company may have against the Licensee.

Mothing in this section contained shall obligate the Licensee to remove the pipe line because of termination of this license with respect to same under the provisions of section. A hereof, in cases where the Licensee shall have made arrangements for the continuation of such pipe line with the grantee or grantees of the Railroad Company.

WAIVER OF BREACH:
The waiver by the Railroad Company of the breach of any condition, sevenant or agreement herein contained to be kept, observed and performed by the Licensee, shall in no way impair the right of the Railroad Company to avail itself of any subsequent breach thereof.

AGREEMENT NOT TO BE ASSIGNED: The Licensee shall not sublet, in whole or in part, the rights hereby granted and shall not assign this agree-ment without the written consent of the Railroad Company, and it is agreed that any transfer or assignment or attempted transfer er assignment of this agreement or any of the rights hereby granted, whether voluntary, by operation of law, or otherwise, without such consent, in writing, shall be abso-lutely void and, at the option of the Railroad Company, shall terminete this egreement. terminate this agreement.

- 15. EFFECTIVE DATE TERM; This agreement shall be effective from and after the 24th day of March, 1947, and shall continue in full force and effect until terminated as herein provided.
- 16. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS: Subject to the provisions of Section 14 hereof; this agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the bene-fit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

17. RENTAL: For the right herein granted to it the Licensee upon the execution and delivery of this agreement, pay to the Union Pacific Railroad Company the sum of TEN

DOLLARS (\$10.00).
