AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PARK STRIPS in Blocks 13, 14 and 20, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. That the following park strips in Blocks 13, 14 and 20, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey, Salt Lake City, Utah, to-wit:

Park Strips located along the east side of 3rd East Street and along the west side of 4th East Street, between Harrison and Cleveland Avenues, dedicated forever for the use of the public, as shown on subdivision map on file in the office of the County Recorder of "The Chicago Addition to Salt Lake City", more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Chicago Add. of Block 13, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey; running thence south 504.0 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 504.0 ft., thence east 33 ft., to point of beginning; also beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 40, Block 2, said Chicago Add.; running thence east 26.17 ft. to the west line of 4th East Street; thence south 504.0 ft.; thence west 26.17 ft., thence north 504.0 ft. to point of beginning.

Park strips located along the east side of 4th East Street and along the west side of 5th East Street, between Harrison and Cleveland Avenues, as shown on subdivision map on file in the office of the County Recorder of "Rice and Gelder's First Addition to Salt Lake City"; more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 40, Block 2, Rice & Gelder's 1st Add. of Block 13, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey; running thence south 503.9 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 503.9 ft., thence east 33.0 ft., to point of beginning; also beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 1, said Rice & Gelder's First Add., running thence east 33.0 ft., thence south 503.9 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 503.9 ft., to point of beginning.

Park strips located along the east side of 5th East Street and along the west side of 6th East Street from Browning Avenue north 254.1 ft., dedicated to the use of the public forever, as shown on subdivision map on file in the office of the County Recorder, of "Watkin's Addition," more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 20, Block 1, Watkin's Add. of Block

14, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey; running thence south 254.1 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 254.1 ft., thence east 33.0 ft. to point of beginning; also beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 2, said Watkin's Add., running thence east 33.0 ft., thence south 254.1 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 254.1 ft., to point of beginning.

Park strip located along the east side of 5th East Street from Kensington Ave. south 252.1 ft., as shown on subdivision map on file in the office of the County Recorder of "Kensington Subdivision," more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 11, Block 2, Kensington Sub. of Block 14, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey, running thence south 252.1 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 252.1 ft., thence east 33.0 ft. to point of beginning.

Park strips located along the west side of 5th East Street between William's and Herbert Avenues and from William's Ave. north 379.85 ft., dedicated for the perpetual use of the public as shown on subdivision map on file in the office of the County Recorder of the "Amended Plat of Denver Place," more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 17, Block 1, Denver Place Amended Plat, a subdivision of Block 20, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey, running thence east 33.0 ft., thence south 382.65 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 382.65 ft. to point of beginning; also beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 17, Block 4, said Denver Place Amended Plat, running thence east 33.0 ft., thence south 379.85 ft., thence west 33.0 ft., thence north 379.85 ft., to point of beginning. And the same are hereby vacated and declared no longer public property as park strips.

SECTION 2. In the opinion of the Board of Commissioners, it is necessary to the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of Salt Lake City that this ordinance shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its first publication.
