PERIOD AND NATURE OF USE. FROM JANUARY 1 TO DECEMBER 31 INCLUSIVE OF EACH YEAR FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES AND PURPOSES INCIDENTAL THERETO

Whereas, it has been made to appear to the satisfaction of the undersigned that the appropriation of water has been perfected in accordance with the Laws of Utah; therefore, be it known that I, HAROLD A. LINKE, the duly appointed, qualified and acting State Engineer, by authority of the Laws of Utah, do hereby certify that said appropriation is entitled to the use of water as herein set out, subject to prior rights, if any, for diversion and use as follows, to wit:

The water appropriated is yielded by a flowing well fully cased with 2 in. black iron pipe driven to a depth of 249 ft. below ground surface, situated S 4091.0 ft. and E 1634.0 ft. from NW Cor. Sec. 30, T13 R1E S18&M. From the well, the water is conveyed S 20.0 ft. through a 1 in. galvanized iron pipe to an electrically-driven pump discharging into a 10 gallon pneumatic tank located in the basement of the house. From the tank, the water appropriated is distributed within said house through 25 ft. of 1/2 in. galvanized iron pipe, where it is, during the entire year, intermittently released and used for domestic purposes in serving one family. The water appropriated is, during the period from April 1 to October 31 of each year, from an outdoor outlet intermittently released and used through garden hose to irrigate 3500 square ft. of lawn and garden surrounding the dwelling.

The amount of water appropriated for incidental irrigation is limited to an amount less than that appropriated for domestic (household) purposes.

The works employed in this appropriation are to be operated and maintained in such manner and condition as will prevent waste of water.
