HAVKER HEIGHTS, A SUBDIVISION

PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, GEORGE H. SMEATH and MARY H. SMEATH, his wife, have heretofore caused to be surveyed, platted and subdivided into lots and streets the following described real property located in Salt Lake County, State of Wtah, to wit:

Reginning at a point South 39° 55' 48" East 562.35 feet and North 110%.51 feet from the South 7 corner of Section 35, Township 1 South Range 1 East, Salt Lake Pase and Meridian, and running thence North 617 feet; thence South 69° 57' East 91.7% feet; thence North 174.68 feet; thence East 653.82 feet; thence South 25'.25 feet; thence North 69° 57' West 155.6% feet; thence South 81.9% feet; thence East 66 feet; thence South 176 57 feet; thence West 12%.92 feet; thence North 22 feet; thence West 191 feet; thence West 124.92 feet; thence West 125 feet; thence West 191 feet; thence West 105 feet; thence West 105 feet; thence West 105 feet; thence West 105 feet to point of beginning.

That the Subdivision so platted is designated and known as "HAWKER 'HEIGHTS"; that the plat thereof was accepted by the Board of Commissioners of Salt Lake County on December 17, 1952 and has been recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Salt Lake County, Utah, in Book "N" of Plats at Page 2, on the 18th day of December, 1952.

That the undersigned GEORGE H. SMEATH and MARY H. SMEATH, his wife, are the owners of all of the land located in said subdivision except the portion thereof dedicated as public streets.

MOU, THEFINERE, all of the lots shown on the plat of "MANKER HEIGHTS" are held and shall be conveyed subject to the restrictions and covenants hereinafter set forth and all persons or corporations who hereafter own or have an interest in any lot in said subdivision shall take and hold the same subject to the agreement and covenant with the other owners, their heirs, successors and assigns, to conform to and observe the same for a period of twenty-five (25) years from the 20th day of December, 1953; provided, however, that each of said restrictions and covenants shall be renewed and automatically continued thereafter for successive periods of twenty-five (25) years each; provided, however, that the owners of the fee simple title of a majority of the front feet of the lots in this subdivision may release all of the lands hereby restricted from any and all said restrictions and covenants at the end of the first twenty-five (25)

year period, or of any successive twenty-five (25) year period, by executing an appropriate agreement in writing for such purpose and filing it, for record, in the Office of the County Recorder of Salt Lake County, Utah, at least five (5) years prior to the expiration of any twenty-five (25) year period.

USE OF LAND:

All of Lots 14 to 27 inclusive, and 29 to 34 inclusive, shall be used only for private single family dwellings of not to exceed two (2) stories in height and a private garage for not more than two (2) cars. All of Lots 1 to 13 inclusive and Lot No. 23 shall be used for either single family dwellings, with the same limitations described above, or for two (2) family dwellings of not to exceed two (2) stories in height and a private garage for not more than two (2) cars. No flat or apartment house shall be created thereon. No animals or fowl shall be housed, maintained or no t on any of the lots, except household pets.

SET PACK OF I PROVERENTS AND ADMITTENANCES:

No building shall be erected on any of said lots nearer than twenty (20) feet to the front lot line, nor nearer than eight (3) feet to any side line. The side line restriction shall not apply to a carage located on the rear one-quarter of any lot, except that on corner lots no structure shall be permitted nearer than ten (10) feet to the side street line.

no trath or pusition precently:

No trade or husiness of any kind or nature shall be permitted on any lot nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.

TEMPORARY STRUCTURES:

No trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuilding shall be moved onto or erected on any lot for use as a residence, temporarily or permanently, and no residence of a temporary character shall be permitted thereon

PLAN, DESIGN AND LOCATION OF EULDING TO BE APPROVED:

No building shall be placed or erected on any lot until the design and location have been approved, in writing, by a committee appointed by a majority of the owners of the lots in the subdivision. Each lot shall have one vote. The undersigned hereby agrees to appoint the original committee within thirty (30) days from date. In the event, however, that such committee shall fail to approve or disaprove a design or location within thirty (30) days after a proval thereof has been requested in writing, then such approval will not be required, provided the design and location on the lot conform to the restrictions herein contained and are in harmony with existing structures in the subdivision.

FULLDIEGS PERCITED:

The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open porches and garaces, shall not be less than mine hundred (900) square feet, in the case of one story single family dwellings, and not less than six hundred (600) square feet in the case of one and a half or two story single family structures. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one story open porches and garages, shall not be less than twelve hundred (1200) square feet in the case of one story two family structures, and not less than eight hundred (600) square feet in the case of one and a half or two story, two family structures.

LOT RE WIRED FOR BUILDING:

No residential structure shall be erected or placed on any building plot which has an area of less than Seven thousand (7000) wquare feet or a width of less than sixtyfive (65) feet at the front building set back line.

DASTITUT FOR UTILITIES:

An ensement is reserved over the rear five (5) feet of each lot, and as otherwise indicated on recorded Plat, for utility installation and maintenance.

RIGHT TO DIFFORCE:

The restrictions herein set forth shall run with the land and bind the owners, their heirs, successors and assigns and all parties claiming by, through or under them shall be taken to hold, agree and covenant with the owners of said lots, their heirs, successors and assigns, and with each of them to comply with and observe said restrictions as to the use of said lots and the construction of improvements thereon, but no restriction herein set forth shall be personally binding on any person, persons or corporation, except in respect

of breaches committed during its, his, her or their seisin of or title to said land, and the owner or owners of any of the lots in said subdivision shall have the right to sue for and obtain an injunction prohibitive or mandatory to prevent the breach of or to enforce the observance of the restrictions above set forth in addition to ordinary legal actions for damages and the failure of the undersigned, GEORGE H. SMEATH and MARY H. SMEATH, his wife, or the owner or owners of any of the lots in this subdivision to enforce any of the restrictions herein set forth at the time of its violation shall, in no event, be deemed a waiver of the right to do so thereafter.

INVALIDATION OF HISTRICTIONS:

The invalidation of any restriction herein contained, by judgement or court order, shall in no way effect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
