## RIGHT OF WAY AND EASEMENT GRANT

Bintz, his wife, located in the Northeast quarter of Section 15, Township 2 South, Range l East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, as shown on attached Mountain Fuel Supply Company drawing No. 3272, referred to and incorporated herein by reference.

The center line of said right of way and easement shall extend through and across the above land and premises as shown in red on attached Mountain Fuel Supply Company drawing No. 3272, referred to and incorporated herein by reference.

TO WAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mountain Fuel Supply Company, its successors and assigns, so long as such pipe line or lines, valves or valve boxes and other gas distribution facilities shall be maintained, with the right of ingress and egress to and from said right of way to maintain, operate, repair, inspect, protect, remove and replace the same.
