WHERE AS, a subdivision known as the CHAPEL SUBDIVISION, owned by Louis D. Nelson is hereby governed by the following restrictions and covenants:

- A. One and Two families, dwellings of not less than $845\ \mathrm{square}$ feet and a private garage for not more than two automobiles may be constructed.
- B. Plans and specifications of proposed dwellings must be submitted to the above named party and approval given by him before construction begins.
- C. No trailer, basement, tent, garage, or other out-building erected in, upon or about any of said lots hereinbefore described or any part thereof shall at any time be used as a residence temporarily or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.
- D. No structure shall be moved onto any residential lot hereinbefore described or any part therefore unless it meets with the approval of the under signed executors, such approval to be given in writing.
- E. Minimum set-back and side yard clearances shall conform with Midvale City regulations.
- F. Not more than one dog and one cat will be permitted to any one family. No horses, cows or hogs or other animals of like nature will be permitted to be raised on said premises.
- G. No signs, billboards, or advertising structures may be erected or displayed on any of the residential lots, except that a single sign, not more than 3 X 4 feet in size, advertising a house for rent or sale, may be displayed on the premises affected.
- H. All homes shall be constructed of firebrick or of fire brick veneer.
- I. Any variance from these covenants must be agreed to in writing by the subdivider, his wife or Louis C. Nelson.
- J. These covenants and restrictions to be in force 25 years and may be extended for successive periods of ten (10) years by a vote of the majority of the then owners of said residential lots.
