RIGHT OF WAY GRANT

South west quarter of Section twenty-five in Township Four, North, Range Two East, Salt Lake Meridian in Morgan County, State of Utah, with ingress and egress to and from the same. No telephone poles in cultivated fields.

The said grantors, their heirs, legal representatives and assigns, to fully use and enjoy the said premises except for the purpose hereinbefore granted to the said UINTA PIPE LIME COMPANY, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise from the laying, erecting, maintaining, operating, repairing or removing said pipe, telephone or telegraph line or lines or any part or parts thereof.

This grant and easement shall at all times be deemed to be, and shall be a continuing scovenant running with the land and shall be binding upon the heirs, legal representatives and assigns of the first parties herein.
