BE IT KNOWN TO ALL SELLERS, BUYERS, AND TITLE COMPANIES that:

- 1. The name and address of the beneficiary under the above referenced Reinvestment Fee Covenant is C Street Townhomes Homeowner's Association, PO Box 1722, Draper, Utah 84020. If and when the contact information is this paragraph becomes outdated, contact with the Association may be made through its registered agent. The current registered agent of the Association can be found through the Utah Department of Commerce, Division of Corporations.
- 2. The burden of the above referenced Reinvestment Fee Covenant is intended to run with the Property, described in **Exhibit "A"**, and to bind successors in interest and assigns. The duration of the above referenced Reinvestment Fee Covenant shall continue and remain in full force and effect until there is recorded an instrument directing the termination or amendment of such Reinvestment Fee Covenant, as provided in the Association's governing documents.
- 3. As of the date of this Reinvestment Fee Covenant, a one-time reinvestment fee shall be paid to the Association when a change in ownership or transfer of a Lot occurs in the in the amount of \$750.00 for the first buyer of each Lot and thereafter in the amount of \$1,000.00, for every subsequent buyer, unless a different amount is determined by the Board from time to time. Such amount shall be in addition to any pro rata share of assessments due and adjusted at settlement. The existence of the Reinvestment Fee Covenant precludes the imposition of an additional reinvestment fee covenant on the burdened property. The purpose of this reinvestment fee is to benefit the burdened property by facilitating the administration, maintenance, and operations of the Association's Common Areas and facilities, and Association expenses.
