To All to whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting:
Whereas, the Cedar Shup Association, a Corporation, of Cedar City,
of the County of Iron, herebefore purchased from the State of Utah,
the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State
in such case made and provided,

And Whereas, the said The Cedar Shup Association, a corporation
has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and
the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of
Six Hundred (\$600 00) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon, accord
as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in
the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

Now, Therefore, I William Spry, Governor in consideration of the
premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by
the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do
issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the State
of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said The Cedar
Shup Association, a corporation and to its Successors and assigns
forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Iron
State aforesaid, to wit:

The North West quarter (N.W. 1/4); North Half (N. 1/2) of the South West
Quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Section 34 in Township 35 South Range 12 West of
the Salt Lake Meridian, containing Two Hundred Forty (240)
acres, according to the said certificate, To have and To hold the
above described and granted premises unto the said The Cedar Shup
Association, a corporation and to its Successors and assigns forever,
subject to any easement, or right of way, of the public, to use all
such highways as may have been established according to law,
over the same or any part thereof, and subject also to all rights
of way for ditches, tunnels, and telephones and transmission lines that
may have been constructed by authority of the United States.
