GRANTORS shall have the right to use said premises except for the purpose for which this right-of-way and easement is granted to the said GRANTES, provided such use shall not interfere with the Facilities or which the collection and conveyance of sewage, storm drainage and water through said Facilities, or any other rights granted to the GRANTEE hereunder.
