Whereas, Cedar Mercantile and Live Stock Co., a corporation of Cedar City

B-281-11 of the County of Iron State of Utah heretofore purchased from the State of Utah
the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such
case made and provided,

And Whereas, the said Cedar Mercantile and Live Stock Co., a corporation
has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and
the laws of the State duly enacted, in relation thereto, the sum of Sixty
(\$60.00) Dollars and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears
by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary
of State of the State of Utah;

Now Therefore, I, William Spry, Governor, in consideration of the premises
and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the
State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this Patent, in the
name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and con-
firming unto the said Cedar Mercantile and Live Stock Co., a corporation
and to its successors and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of
land, situate in the County of Washington State aforesaid, to-wit:

The North West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section
Nineteen (19) in Township Sixty-eight (38) South Range Ten (10) West of the
Salt Lake Meridian, - Reserving to the United States all coal in the
lands herein conveyed and to its, or persons authorized by it, the
right to prospect for, mine and remove coal from the same upon
compliance with the conditions of, and subject to the limitations of
an Act of Congress approved March 3-1907 (35 Stat. 847) containing
forty (40) acres according to the said certificate.

To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises
unto the said Cedar Mercantile and Live Stock Co., a corporation
and to its successors and assigns forever, subject to any easement
or right of way as may have been established or acquired accord-
ing to law, over the same or any part thereof and subject also
to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels, and telephone and telegraph
