## ARTICLE IV PROPERTY RIGHTS: RIGHTS OF ENJOYMENT

**Noise Ordinance Enforcement.** Each Owner is entitled to quiet enjoyment. Loud parties, music or other disturbances after 10:00 p.m. that interfere with the quiet enjoyment will not be permitted. Any disturbances after 10:00 p.m. will result in a \$50 fine for the first offence, \$75 for the second offence, and \$100 for each violation thereafter. Violations will also be reported to local authorities as a violation of the City Noise Ordinance.
