WHEREAS, the Property Owner is the owner of real property more particularly described on Exhibit A attached hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the Property") and on which the Facilities are located, and

WHEREAS, The City of Washington (hereinafter referred to as "the City") and the Property Owner, or its administrators, executors, successors, heirs, or assigns, including any homeowners association, agree that the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City require that the Facilities be constructed and maintained on the property, and

WHEREAS, it is required that the Facilities as shown on the approved development plans and specifications be constructed and maintained by the Property Owner, its administrators executors, successors, heirs, or assigns, including any homeowners association.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the mutual covenants contained herein, and the following terms and conditions, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SECTION 1

The Facilities shall be constructed by the Property Owner in accordance with the approved plans and specifications for the development.

SECTION 2

The Property Owner, its administrators, executors successors, heirs or assigns, including any homeowners association, shall maintain the Facilities in good working condition acceptable to the City and in accordance with the Schedule of Long Term Maintenance Activities agreed hereto and attached as Exhibit B.

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SECTION 3

The Property Owner, its administrators, executors, successors, heirs or assigns, including any homeowners association, hereby grants permission to the City, its authorized agents and employees to enter upon the property and to inspect the Facilities whenever the City deems necessary. Whenever possible, the City shall provide notice prior to entry. Alleasements as shown on the Final Plat shall be maintained to allow access to the Facilities.

SECTION 4

In the event the Property Owner is administrators, executors, successors, heirs or assigns, including any homeowners association, fails to maintain the Facilities as shown on the approved plans and specifications in good working order acceptable to the City, the City, with due notice, may enter the property and take whatever steps it deems necessary to return the Facilities to good working order. This provision shall not be construed to allow the City to erect any structure of a permanent nature on the property. It is expressly understood and agreed that the City is under no obligation to maintain or repair the Facilities and in no event shall this Agreement be construed to impose any such obligation on the City.

SECTION 5

In the event the City, pursuant to the Agreement, performs work of any pature, or expends any ands in the performance of said work for labor, use of equipment, supplies, materials, and the The Property Owner shall reinburse the City within thirty 30 days of receipt thereof for all the costs incurred by the City Hereunder. If not paid within the prescribed time period, the City shall secure a lien against the real property of the costs incurred by the City Hereunder. shall secure a lien against the real property in the amount of such costs. The actions described in this section are in addition to and not in lieu of any and all legal remedies available to the City as a result of the Property Owner's failure to maintain the Facilities.

SECTION 6

It is the intent of this agreement to insure the proper maintenance of the Facilities by the Property Owner; provided, however, that this Agreement shall not be deemed to create or effect any additional liability of any party for damage alleged to result from or caused by storm water runoff.

SECTION 7

Sediment accumulation resulting from the normal operation of the Facilities will be properly removed. The Property Owner will make accommodation for the removal and disposal of all accumulated sediments Accumulated sediments will be disposed of properly offsite.

SECTION'8

The Property Owner shall use the standard SMP Operation and Maintenance Checklist, available from the City and by this reference made a part hereof for the purpose of a minimal annual inspection of the Facilities by a qualified inspector. This annual inspection shall be submitted to the Ein on or before July 1st each year, after inspection is completed by Qualified inspector.
