Condemnation The proceeds of any award or staim for damages, direct or consequential, payable to Borrower In connection with any condemnation or other taking of all or any part of the Property or the common areas and facilities of the PUD, offor any conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender. Such proceeds shall be applied by Lender to the sums secured by the Security Instrument as provided in Section 11. E. Lender's Prior Consent.
