(b) Avoiding Foreclosure: Mitigating Losses. Any such agreements will not: (i) affect the amounts that Borrower has agreed to pay for Mortgage Insurance for any other terms of the Loan; (ii) increase the amount Borrow்ளில் owe for Mortgage Insurance; (iii) இrtitle Borrower to any refund; or (iv) affect the rights Borrower has, if any, with respect to the Mortgage Insurance under the Homeowith ers Protection Act of 1998 (12 U.S.C. § 4901 et seq.), as it may be amended from time to time, or any additional or successor lederal legislation or regulation that soverns the same subject matter ("HPA"). Borrower or any Successor in Interest of Borrower will not be released from liability under this Security Instrument if Lender extends the time for payment or modifies the amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument. Lender will not be required to commence proceedings against any Successor in Interest of Borrower, or to refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument, by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or any Successors in Interest of Borrower. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy including, without limitation, Lengler's acceptance of payments from third persons, entities, or Successors in Interest of Borrower or in amounts less than the amount their due, will not be a waiver of, or preclude the exercise of, any right or remedy by Lender.
