CONSENT TO PERPETUAL EASEMENT

(Parcel No. 181:1:1

SALT LAKE CITY, a municipal corporation of the State of Utah, hereby grants to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH a perpetual easement for highway right of way across and upon the hereinafter described real property for the purpose hereinafter set forth.

The lands hereinafter described are presently being used by Salt Lake City Corporation for reservoir and conduit installations.

The lands which the City by this Consent to Perpetual Easement allows the State Road Commission to use are located in the County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, and are more particularly described as follows:


Beginning at the NE corner of said entire tract of property, which point is 1711.48 feet east, 63.37 feet north, 854.30 ft. S. 89°59'54" E. and 424.52 ft. N. 19°34' W. from the City Monument at the intersection of 13th East Street and 5th South Street; thence N. 89°59'54"W. 168.88 ft. to a point 50.00 ft. radially distant southerly from the center line of said highway project; thence Easterly 200.72 ft. along the arc of a 6027.07 ft. radius curve to the left to the easterly boundary line of said entire tract of property (Note: Tangent to said curve at its point of beginning bears S. 71°06'06" E.); thence N. 19°34' W. 65.74 ft. to the point of beginning as shown on the official map of said project on file in the office of the State Road Commission of Utah; said parcel of land contains 0.12 acre, more or less.

By accepting the use of said described property, the State Road Commission agrees that the use of said land shall be restricted to construction and maintenance of a roadway on the University of Utah Campus; and that in the construction, operation, and maintenance of the said roadway, the State Road Commission and all other parties who may be involved in said operation will protect in a manner satisfactory to the City Engineer and the Department of Water Supply and Waterworks of said City any of the City's existing facilities which now cross through the above described property.
