The court decrees:

**Divorce**

1. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** is granted a divorce based on his Affidavit of Jurisdiction and Grounds. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

**Children**

2. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** and **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** are the legal parents of the following children (Utah Code 78B-15-101 et seq.). This court has jurisdiction to make orders about these children.

a. **Kamia Harumi Baldwin**                      **Born 03/16/2015**

**Children - custody**

3. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** is awarded sole legal and sole physical custody of the children. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** will have parent-time at reasonable times and places.

**Parent-time**

4. The parents will follow a custom parent-time schedule.

The children will live with **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** and will have parent-time with **Michael Kenji Baldwin** according to a custom parent-time schedule. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** will be the “custodial” parent:

**Each year during the summer when school is not in session, Kamia Baldwin may elect to spend her summer vacations with her father, Michael Baldwin. Schedule will be coordinated depending on school start/end dates with Hanna Lynn Baldwin. Michael Baldwin will ensure Kamia Baldwin is returned home with Hanna Lynn Baldwin no less than two weeks prior to the start of the new school year. At any time, Kamia Baldwin may elect to cancel/refuse the summer trips and Michael Baldwin will return her home to Hanna Lynn Baldwin as soon as possible. Other holidays may also be planned/approved at Hanna Lynn and Kamia Baldwin's discretion, but at a minimum, the family will plan for summer visits each year. Michael Baldwin will have parent time with Kamia Baldwin during any holidays that fall within these visits.**

**Parent-time for special occasions**

5. The parents will follow the schedule for special occasions below. If there is more than one child and the children's school schedules vary for purpose of a holiday, at the option of the parent exercising the holiday or the parent's half of the holiday, the children may remain together for the holiday period beginning the first evening that all children's schools are let out for the holiday and ending the evening before any child returns to school. (Utah Code 30-3-32, 35)

6. Pick-up and drop-off (“transfers”) of the children for parent-time will be as described below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

**Education Plan**

- 7. The school the children will attend is based on **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin's** home residence.
- 8. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** has authority to check the children out of school.
- 9. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** has authority to check the children out of school.
- 10. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** has access to the children during school.
- 11. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** has access to the children during school.

**Communication with each other**

12. Parents will communicate with each other by any method.

**Communication with the children**

13. The parents agree they will:

- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
- give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.

Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.

By any method

### **Records and information sharing**

14. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

### **Travel by the children**

15. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with others. If the children will be travelling for more than **2** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **5** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **5** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.

### **Relocation of a parent** (Utah Code 30-3-37)

16. If either parent moves more than 149 miles from the other, the moving parent must give the non-moving parent a written Notice of Relocation. The notice must be sent at least 60 days before the planned move.

The written Notice of Relocation must include:

- Information about the move;
- A proposed parent-time schedule; and
- A statement that the parents will not interfere with the other parent's parent-time.

If the moving parent does not give the non-moving parent a Notice of Relocation, the moving parent will be in contempt of the Court's order.

17. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other, or if the parents live a different countries, parent-time will be as the parties agree. If they are unable to agree, the following will be the minimum parent-time for the noncustodial parent:

Relocation Schedule (Utah Code 30-3-37)

- a. in years ending in odd number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:
  - i. Thanksgiving holiday beginning Wednesday until Sunday; and
  - ii. spring break, if applicable, beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes;
- b. in years ending in an even number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:
  - i. the entire winter school break period; and
  - ii. the fall school break beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes; and
- c. extended parent-time equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the summer or off-track time for consecutive weeks. The children will be returned to the custodial home no later than seven days before school begins. This week will be counted when determining the amount of parent-time to be divided between the parents for the summer or off-track period. The parties will mutually agree on this extended time each year. If they are unable to agree, the noncustodial parent will select the dates for the extended time period.
- d. One weekend per month at the option and expense of the noncustodial parent. The noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement is subject to the following restrictions.
  - i. If the noncustodial parent has not designated a specific weekend for parent-time, the noncustodial parent will receive the last weekend of each month unless a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on that particular weekend. If a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on the last weekend of the month, the noncustodial parent will be entitled to the next to the last weekend of the month.
  - ii. If a noncustodial parent's extended parent-time or parent-time over a holiday extends into or through the first weekend of the next month, that weekend will be considered the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement for that month.
  - iii. If a child is out of school for teacher development days or snow days after the children begin the school year, or other days not included in the list of holidays in Subsection (5) and those days are contiguous with the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend parent-time, those days will be included in the weekend parent-time.

e. The custodial parent is entitled to all parent-time not specifically allocated to the noncustodial parent.

18. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be shared equally.

If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.

Reimbursement the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

**Income: Michael Kenji Baldwin** (Utah Code 78B-12-203)

19. **Michael Kenji Baldwin's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$4,848.00**. His base child support amount using the sole custody calculation is **\$519.00** per month. He receives the following gross monthly income:

- a. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** is employed at **DEFENSE FINANCE & ACTG SERV.** He earns **\$4,848.13** gross (pre-tax) monthly income working a 40-hour a week job or less.

**Income: Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin**

20. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$4,333.00**. Her base child support amount using the sole custody calculation is **\$464.00** per month. She receives the following gross monthly income:

- a. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** is employed at **NAVY CYP NAFI** and grosses **\$2,080.00** per month. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** is voluntarily underemployed and is capable of working at a job which pays more. Based upon **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin's** work experience during the period of the parties' marriage, gross monthly income should be attributed to **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** in the amount of **\$4,333.00** per month.

**Child support** (Utah Code 78B-12-202 et seq.)

21. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** is ordered to pay child support to **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** as follows:

a. **\$519.00** per month base support. This amount complies with the Utah Child Support Act.

Support for each child ends when:

- a child turns 18 or has graduated from high school during the child's normal and expected year of graduation, whichever occurs later (Utah Code 78B-12-219(1)), or
- a child dies, marries, becomes a member of the United States armed forces, or is emancipated (Utah Code 78B-12-219(1), Utah Code 78A-6-801).

22. Child support payments will start the month immediately following entry of the order.

The payment schedule will be:

- one half by the 5<sup>th</sup> day of each month, and
- the other half by the 20<sup>th</sup> day of each month.

Child support not paid by the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the month is past due on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of the month. Child support not paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the month is past due on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of the month. If the Office of Recovery Services is used to collect support, their payment schedule will be followed.

23. The sole custody worksheet was used to calculate child support.

- **Michael Kenji Baldwin's** base child support amount is **\$519.00** per month.
- **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin's** base child support amount is **\$464.00** per month.

If physical custody of a child changes from what the court orders:

- The parent owing support must pay the support amount to whomever has physical custody of the child.
- The parent must pay the support amount without asking the court to modify the child support order.
- This does not apply to temporary parent-time changes. (Utah Code 78B-12-108).

### **Child Support Reduction for Extended Parent-Time**

24. If a child lives with the non-custodial parent by court order or written agreement of the parties for:

- 25 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 50% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 78B-12-216(1)(a)).
- 12 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 25% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 78B-12-216(1)(b)).

The custodial parent's normal parent-time and holiday parent-time do not count as an interruption of the consecutive day requirement.

25. If a child receives cash assistance through the T.A.N.F. or F.E.P. programs, any agreement by the parties to reduce child support during extended parent-time must be approved by the Office of Recovery Services.

26. The person ordered to receive child support can request mandatory income withholding (Utah Code 62A-11 parts 4 and 5). If support is past due, the State of Utah may take federal or state tax refunds or rebates and apply the amounts to the child support owed.

Withheld income will be sent to the Office of Recovery Services (ORS) until all past-due support is paid. Child support payments will be sent to:

unless ORS gives notice that payments should be sent elsewhere.

If ORS begins mandatory income withholding, child support is due on the first day of each month and will be past due on the first day of the next month.

27. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** will pay any ORS fees. If **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** is the ORS applicant and the fees are withheld from payments to **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin**, **Michael Kenji Baldwin** will reimburse **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin**.

28. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or

administrative action.

29. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.

30. The parties can ask to change this child support order by motion after three years from the date of its entry if:

- there is a difference of 10% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines,
- the difference is not temporary, and
- the amount previously ordered was not a deviation from the child support guidelines.

(Utah Code 78B-12-210(8)).

If the children receive TANF funds at the time an adjustment is sought, ORS will review the order and ask the court to adjust the amount if appropriate. (Utah Code 62A-11-306.2).

31. The parties can ask to change this child support order at any time by petition if there has been a substantial change in circumstances because of material changes in:

- custody;
- the relative wealth or assets of the parties;
- income of a parent of 30% or more;
- the employment potential and ability of a parent to earn;
- the medical needs of the child; or
- the legal responsibilities of either parent for the support of others.

(Utah Code 78B-12-210(7) and (9)).

The change must result in a difference of 15% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines. The difference may not be temporary.

The court can consider natural or adoptive children born after the entry of the decree other than those in common to both parties as part of a request to modify an existing award subject to limitations in the law. (Utah Code 78B-12-210(7)).

**Dependent children for tax purposes**

32. **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes.

**Child health care** (Utah Code 78B-12-212)

33. **Michael Kenji Baldwin** must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost.

a. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin's** insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Michael Kenji Baldwin's** insurance will be secondary coverage.

b. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Hanna Lynn Agualo Baldwin spouse's** insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Michael Kenji Baldwin spouse's** insurance will be secondary coverage.

c. Both parties will equally share the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.

d. Both parties will equally share all uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.

e. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.

f. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.



g. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.

h. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

34. Neither party has received or is receiving public assistance from the State of Utah.

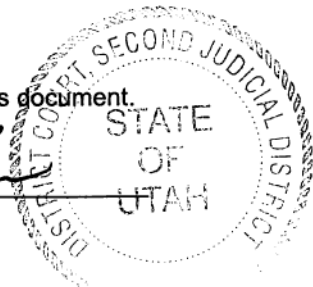
**Duty to sign documents**
