

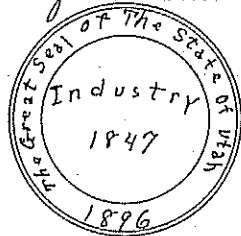

Whereas, Joseph C. Jones of the County of Salt Lake heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided,

Jones has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Fifty Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

Now Therefore, I Heber M. Wells, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said Joseph C. Jones and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Salt Lake State aforesaid, to-wit:

The South-east quarter of the South-west quarter of Section Nine in Township Three South of Range One West of the Salt Lake Meridian, containing Forty acres according to the said certificate.

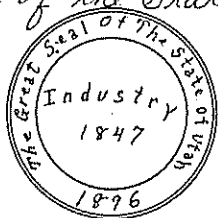
