SUPPLEMENTARY DECLARATION OF COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

THIS DECLARATION, made this 20th day of June, 1975, by BELL MOUNTAIN CORPORATION, a Utah Corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Declarant":

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Declarant is the owner of the real property in the County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, described as:

Lots 301 through 340 inclusive in Pepperwood Phase III.

WHEREAS, Declarant has deemed it desirable to impose a general plan for the improvement and development of the portion of said tract and all of the property described herein and the adoption and establishment of covenants, conditions and restrictions upon said real property and each and every lot and portion thereof and upon the use, occupancy and enjoyment thereof, all for the purpose of enhancing and protecting the value, desirability, and attractiveness of said tract; and

WHEREAS, Declarant has deemed it desirable for the efficient preservation of the value, desirability and attractiveness of the portion of said tract and has heretofore created a corporation to which has been delegated and assigned to powers of maintaining and administering the common area and administering and enforcing these covenants, conditions and restrictions and collecting and disbursing funds pursuant to the assessment and charges hereinafter created and referred to; and
