Grant of Easement.

Thomas A. Howard and Sarah E. Howard, his wife, Grantors, of Holliday, Salt Lake County, Utah, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to them in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer and convey to Tako Company, a corporation of the State of Utah, and to its successors and assigns forever, an easement and right of way 20 feet in width, for general purposes of travel, in over and upon the Grantors' land in said County, situate in the Southwest Quarter of Section 2 and the Southeast Quarter of Section 3, in Township 2 South of Range 1 East Salt Lake Meridian, as the roadway therefor is now constructed and used by the Grantee for purposes of ingress and egress to and from its land in the Southwest Quarter of said Section 2, said roadway being routed approximately as follows, to wit:

Commencing at a point on Seventeenth South Street about 100 rods east of Neilson's store at the corner of the Upper County Road and said Seventeenth South Street, and running thence southerly about 60 rods to the Grantors' barn, thence easterly about 20 rods across the Upper Big Cottonwood Canal, thence south-easterly a distance of about 5 rods to the north bank of Spring Creek, thence easterly a distance of about 150 rods on the upland along the north bank of said Spring Creek and the north branch of said Spring Creek, entering the Grantee's said land from the north at a point near the head waters of the north branch of said Spring Creek.
