In the event that the association at any time fails to properly maintain these things required by ordinance (including but not limited to the shrubs, trees, grass, parks, recreation facilities and other amenities), the Town of Garden City may in its sole discretion enter upon and make any and all repairs, or may maintain any of the properties within its jurisdiction, and may then charge the association for all such repairs, maintenance and protection, provided, however, that the Town shall under no Circumstances be obligated to take such action.
