

## ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (414 City & County Building), and that on the 4th day of August, 1980, Case No. 8379 by S. Emil Langeland was heard by the Board. Mr. Langeland requested a variance on the property at 371 Virginia Street to construct a single-family dwelling, the retaining wall in conjunction with which would change the grade more than the permitted two feet in a Residential "R-1" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing 1754.36 feet South and 420.84 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and running thence South 82° West 52.00 feet Westerly and along a curve to the left, 38.767 feet; thence North 18°40'44" West 175.695 feet; thence North 89°58'03" East 124.3 feet; thence South 8° East 151.819 feet to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that a variance be granted to construct a single-family home and have a retaining wall that would exceed the permitted 2' grade change as shown on the plans presented by the petitioner. If a permit is not taken out in six months the variance will expire.
