A RESOLUTION APPROVING A QUIT-CLAIM DEED, VACATING A CULINARY WATER EASEMENT, ON REAL PROPERTY, LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 100 WEST 2675 NORTH

WHEREAS, Leadership Learning Academy, Inc. (LLA) owns real property, which is located at approximately 100 West 2675 North; and

WHEREAS, Windsor Square Commercial Phase 3 dedication plat has dedicated an easement for a culinary water line that was proposed to connect to the culinary water system in Rolling Hills to Layton City; and

WHEREAS, Layton City Public Works has determined that the culinary water connection to Rolling Hills is no longer needed for the proper function of the water system; and

WHEREAS, the LLA desires to construct an addition to the existing building requiring the relocation of a private fire hydrant, which is connected to a private culinary water line; and

WHEREAS, due to the culinary water line being private, the connection to Rolling Hills no longer being needed and the City's ownership of the easement being unnecessary, Layton City desires to Quit-Claim its interest in the existing culinary water line easement to LLA; and

- That the City Quit-Claim its interest in the culinary water line easement to Leadership Learning Academy, Inc., which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference
- 2. That the Mayor be authorized to sign the said Quit-Claim Deed and vacate the said easement on behalf of the City.
