ORDINANCE NO. 755

DATE: August 12, 1981

AN ORDINANCE OF SALT LAKE COUNTY, UTAH, CHANGING THE NAME AND DESIGNATION OF 8220 SOUTH STREET IN THE BAIR ESTATES #1 SUB-DIVISION, SALT LAKE COUNTY, UTAH, TO TREE FARM LANE.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salt Lake ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Salt Lake County Ordinance No. 755 is hereby passed and enacted, said ordinance to read as follows:

- (1) That the designation of 8220 South Street in the Bair Estates #1 Subdivision, Salt Lake County, Utah, is hereby changed in name and designation to Tree Farm Lane, and shall be hereafter officially known by such name.
- (2) The Board of County Commissioners finds and is satisfied that the changing of the name and designation of this street will not be detrimental to the general interest, that neither the public nor any person will be materially injured thereby and that it should be made.
- (3) The County Recorder shall record this ordinance and make the necessary changes to the official plats and records of the County to accomplish the purpose hereof.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon at least one publication in a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Salt Lake County.
