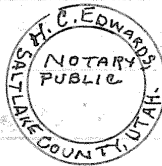

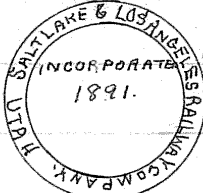

The Salt Lake & Los Angeles Railway Company, a Utah corporation, for one Dollar and other valuable considerations paid by The Telluride Power Company, a Colorado corporation, hereby grants to said Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to erect, operate and maintain during the period of the franchise of the said Railway Company, electric power transmission circuits and appurtenances attached to a single line of poles or other supports and necessary fixtures, on, over and along said Railway Company's right-of-way extending from the point of intersection of said right-of-way with Highway No. 32, in Salt Lake County, Utah, westerly along the southern boundary thereof to the north-west corner of Section 2 Township 1 South, Range 3 West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence southerly along the eastern boundary of said right-of-way to the works of the Inland Crystal Salt Company. This grant is given with the understanding that said Railway Company shall not be liable for any damage to the said transmission lines which may be due to fires caused by its locomotives, or from any cause whatsoever.
