Grantors thereinto, to said Porter-Walton Company, Grantee therein, dated March 31st, 1916, and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Salt Lake County, Utah, in Book "9-B" of Deeds, at page 514 thereof, on April 7th, 1916, (and by which said Deed said E. T. Walton conveyed to said Porter-Walton Company all of the interest acquired by him under and by virtue of a certain Deed made, executed and delivered by John S. Corless, Sheriff of Salt Lake County, Utah, Grantor therein, to said E. T. Walton, Grantee therein, dated March 31st, 1916, and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Salt Lake County, Utah, in Book "8-P" of Deeds, at page 333 thereof, on April 7th, 1916), in and to the following described tracts and parcels of land situate in Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, State of Utah, to wit:

Commencing at a point which is North 41 feet from the Southeast corner of Lot 7, Block 29, Plat "A", Salt Lake City Survey, and running thence North 88.43 feet, to the center of a railway spur; thence Southwesterly along the center of said Railway spur, (which said Railway Spur has a curvature of 22° with the vertex to the South) 105.90 feet; thence South 21.65 feet; thence East 81 feet to the place of beginning.

Also a perpetual Right of Way across a strip of land 8 feet wide lying immediately North and adjacent to the center line of Railway curve hereinbefore mentioned and extending the full length of said Railway Spur.
