QUIT CLAIM DEED

PRICE RIVER WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, a body corporate of Carbon County, State of Utah, Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and sufficient considerations, hereby quit-claims to CARBON COUNTY, a body corporate and politic of the State of Utah, Grantee, subject nevertheless to the reservations hereinafter stated, the following described real property within Carbon County, State of Utah, to wit:

Beginning at a point 300 feet North of the West 1/2 corner of Section 10, Township 12 South, Range 7 East, Salt Lake Meridian; thence North 800 feet; thence East 760 feet; thence South 360 feet; thence South-westerly 885 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres.

The Grantor reserves the right at will at any time to inundate any part or the whole of said tract, if to do so becomes necessary or desirable for the impounding of waters by means of what is commonly known as the Scofield Dam and Reservoir
